THE FOLLOWING REPORT IS MADE IN ANSWER TO YOUR MESSAGE
OF 15 JULY 68.

1. THE OBJECTS DID NOT PASS DIRECTLY OVERHEAD. THEY WENT
FROM 360 DEGREES TO 190 DEGREES AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED IN
INITIAL REPORT. THEY WERE AT A VERY HIGH ALTITUDE AND AT
APPROXIMATELY A 11:30 O'CLOCK POSITION FROM ME WHEN THEY
PASSED OVER, WITH ME FACING DUE NORTH.

2. MR. [REDACTED] SAYS THE 0305Z SIGHTING WAS IN VIEW FOR

APPROXIMATELY 3 TO 4 SECONDS

3. MR. [REDACTED] SAID HE HAD THE 0320Z SIGHTING IN

TO 3 MINUTES. [REDACTED] WAS OUTSIDE CHECKING ON
THE 0305Z SIGHTING WHEN THIS SIGHTING TOOK PLACE.

5. FAA AND LOCAL RADARS WERE CHECKED FOR AIRCRAFT IN
THAT AREA. REPORTS FROM THESE INSTALLATIONS WERE NEGATIVE.
