



Report of Unidentified Plying Object

On July 26, 1960, a report was made by a representative of the Magistrate of Petta Island, Trut District, about an object which was mighted near Patta. I decided to investigate the matter and went to Patta on July 27. A statement was taken from one Penian; male, age 19, one of the adults who sighted the object. A translation of the statement is attached and is self-explanatory. In addition, dies drew a sketch of the object, which is attached, as he remembers it. There were also two other persons in the boat who saw the object; one Afechnong, male, ege 37, and one Tiofin, male, age 8. There was not sufficient time before the bost left Petts for the return trip to Hosm to take a statement from Afectionag or Tiofin, but they did, however, verify the statement as told by Pinion. Meither of the two adults have formal educetions but appeared to be reasonably intelligent and elert and completely sincere. While it doesn't appear in the statement, I asked the new if they had been drinking and they replied in the negative. I inquired as to the reputation of the ten men in their community and they are considered reliable and trustworthy.

It is thought that perhaps you may wish to forward the report to Mavel Intelligence for whatever value it may be, if any.
