

<p>Reference your message, AFCIN-4E2X, 7-2282E, 27 July 1960, regarding 7DCOI message 2432, 22 July 1960, further inquiries were made as directed. Pilots flying from Hensley Field did not see any UFO or other object which might have been responsible for the sighting. The GCI site at Duncanville, Texas, did not pick up any UFO's on their radar scopes on the night of the sighting. The Control Tower at Carswell AFB did not receive any reports of a UFO sighting. No other reports were made to this office by anyone concerning UFO's in the 21st or 22nd of July 1960.</p>
