COMMENTS All movement was in a very small area and object gave appearance of going straight up which is characteristic of disappearance of a refracted astronomical object. The star Vega was in the position given by the observer with a magnitude of 0.1. Time of 0500 is 0508 absolute. Vega rose at 0523 absolute. Case listed as refraction of star Vega.
