

concerning UFO sighting. Originated from Indianapolis
Center re-transmitted info from Lafiette, Ind. radio. Sited
0143Z on 5 Sept, located 17 mi. S.W. Object was stationary,
flashing light, and some erratic movements. Haze layer at
time of siting at 8-9000 ft. Hollman tower at Terre Haute.
No reported similar object sited 20 mi S.E. of Terre Haute. No
further info available.
