PILOT STATED THAT HE DID NOT OBSERVE UFO, NO CIVILIAN AIRLINES AIRCRAFT IN THE AREA. NO LOCAL FLIGHTS FROM JAMES CONNALLY AFB IN THE AREA. K. POSITION TITLE AND COMMENTS OF THE PREPARING OFFICER, INCLUDING HIS PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS OF THE POSSIBLE CAUSE OF THE SIGHTING: POSITION: 12TH AIR FORCE DIRECTOR OF INTELLIGENCE, COMMENTS: NEITHER OF THE OBSERVERS NOTED THE EXACT TIME OF THE SIGHTING. TIME REPORTED FOR THIS SIGHTING MAY BE IN ERROR BY PLUS OR MINUS 15 MINUTES. NO ADDITIONAL OBSERVERS REPORTED THIS SIGHTING TO LOCAL NEWSPAPERS. JAMES CONNALLY AFB TOWER PERSONNEL DID NOT OBSERVE UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT.
