THE OBJECT CAME TO THE ATTENTION OF THE WITNESS BECAUSE OF A FLASH OF LIGHT WHICH WAS APPARENTLY REFLECTED FROM IT. THE OBJECT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE DISAPPEARED BY CLIMBING STRAIGHT UP INTO CLOUDS.

EVALUATION: CASE CATEGORY: INSUFFICIENT EVIDENCE

CONCLUSION: THE WITNESS HAS NOT PROVIDED SUFFICIENT INFORMATION TO ALLOW A VALID CONCLUSION. HOWEVER, WHAT INFORMATION THERE IS INDICATES THAT THE CAUSE OF THIS SIGHTING WAS PROBABLY A REFLECTION, MIRAGE OR BOTH.


