A. (1) BULLET WITH FLAMING TAIL

(2) ONE PILOT BELIEVED ACTUAL SIZE APPROX SAME AS HIS AIRCRAFT. OTHERS BELIEVED CONSIDERABLY SMALLER. DIMENSIONS AS VIEWED FROM AIRCRAFT: DIAM ONE INCH TO FIVE INCHES; LENGTH FIVE INCHES TO TWO FEET.

(3) NOSE AREA RED WITH BLUE/GREEN CENTER FOLLOWED BY A NARROW BAND OF RED FLAME AND WHITE TAIL.

(4) ONE, EXCEPT THAT THE TWO PILOTS IN F-104B REPORTED OBJECT SEPARATED INTO TWO DURING LAST SIX OF THE TOTAL TEN SECONDS. OBJECT WAS UNDER THEIR OBSERVATION.

(5) NORMAL CLOSE WHEN OBSERVED AS TWO.

(6) GENERAL CONSISTENCY HOT, MOLTEN, GLOWING.

(7) WHITE TAIL INCLUDED IN DESCRIPTION WAS APPROX ONE HALF OF TOTAL LENGTH. IN ADDITION THREE OF FOUR PILOTS REPORTED A STREAMER LIKE CONTRAIL TEN TIMES TOTAL LENGTH OF OBJECT. THESE THREE PRINCIPALS STATED STREAMER, IF A CONTRAIL, WAS OF EXTREMELY SHORT DURATION (FIVE OR SIX SECONDS).
