Dear Sir:

Have just recently found what wrote at this time the report - 4 months late. Sorry, but hope it is of some interest to you.

Date of sighting: April 20, 1961 <sup>morning</sup>

Time: Between 2 & 3 P.M. (near 2:30)

Duration: Several minutes, I believe.

Object as it appeared to observer: Some sort of bird, cigar shaped with 2 fins at tail end. Medium gray color, bill (adjustment change in anyway) unmarked, texture almost rough like that of a beetle. Observer saw no wings, tail, appendages of any kind except the fins and evident intention of the genuine moving slightly or not.

Speed: Observer said the word "cruising" spontaneously since it was going ~~very~~ slowly but surely - no up or down.

Sound: None at all to observer. (not noise of the entire)

Weather: Clear, sunny bright & warm - <sup>in shade</sup> in shade  
Situation & observer: The observer is my mother as she was but outside, always looking out the window, not so much "up" as just "out", passing a bird out in the garden out the back kitchen window she did not dare to write a letter. Suddenly a huge affair burst over. She first did not see the rest of it gradually appeared. Mother was so surprised that she got up from her chair and watched it from the front window & then from other windows until after getting down immediately out the window, it was suddenly gone & passed. She simply could not see it anymore. She number wondering if it was some experimental aircraft & asked the my son who had just come home from school as he was in it too. It appeared to be just skimming the tree tops as it was so close that my mother observed the lack of any other fins except fins. I noted that it had no visible feathers or fins compartments. She was even impressed by its texture. She was not frightened, however, but it stuck in her mind & she dictated up <sup>April 21, 1961.</sup>

Since she told me & now the next day, I checked as far as I could. I called the wife of the F.A. man & her husband happened to be home at the time. Her husband ~~had~~ <sup>had</sup> been called in to him right away & they had been there to discuss nothing about said sighting & his knowledge & he had heard anything about that of it comes happen again - fit to the phone "point".

the mother, she went across the U.S. you might be interested seeing  
nothing - privileged other things to most mothers average citizen.  
Usually found off as Hug Watch. I had heard of quite a bit about mostly  
fantastic stuff that didn't impress me as being too authentic. However I  
had recognized the shape of the thing as being one of a wise kind.  
Mother was completely innocent of this information also you never know  
what the government's going to try next an aircraft. Since we are  
pursue the FAA people (they used to be regulators) we called at their  
office evening, my husband & I. We were unable to get in detail of it so we

that they didn't observe anything in particular. Mother got the information  
& way the next day she changed our residence on N. Linden in Sheridan.

20, 1961 between 2 & 3 pm (I was called into the Sheridan County

but finally sat back relaxed just enjoying the meeting and I saw

off my cap earing automatically, stuck both fingers in with  
was <sup>shaking</sup> my hands on them hard in desperation. I was particularly  
numb for about 4 seconds - the longest seconds imaginable  
I meant something in our red engine. My boyish country  
mother was looking at me quite a bit & said "Why, Major,  
what's wrong?" No we also had heard it & this is the earliest  
we <sup>ever</sup> can say we don't care to hear it again if it can be  
heard. I normally shake! The other <sup>as</sup> don't know just how much
