This is why I did not write earlier.


We are both 15 year old. In your book you mention that you needed sightings that are in great detail. My friend in May, 1961, made such a sighting. I'll let my friend write about it now.

Sometime in May of 1961, I can't remember the day, I saw an U.F.O. It was about 3:55pm and I was standing at the intersection of Wantagh Avenue and Sarah Drive. It was a delta winged craft and it had 2 red and 3 white stripes running from its nose to its back. It also had what appeared to be 3 blue lights mounted on its underside. I saw the craft for about 20 to 30 seconds traveling North to South. It was going pretty fast and then it slowed down and finally stopped in mid-air. Then I couldn't believe my eyes, it went straight up and it disappeared because of its height. I am enclosing a drawing of the craft, which I hope will help you in your investigation.

objects. I'm not sure if they were S.F.O's.


