Object movement tends to indicate balloon sighting, however the winds reported were from the West at lower altitude. The wind at 60,000 was from 030, but at a speed of only 5 knots. This would not move a balloon out of the area in 10 minutes. An air intercept was attempted and the pilot did not make contact with the object. Case listed as insufficient data.
