Appeared to be a great height and heading toward the Southern horizon.		11. COMMENTS Echo ruled out. Object movement tends to indicate balloon sighting, however the winds reported were from the West at lower altitude. The wind at 60,000 was from 030, but at a speed of only 5 knots. This would not move a balloon out of the area in 10 minutes. An air intercept was attempted and the pilot did not make contact with the object. Case listed as insufficient data.
