10. BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING Witnesses noticed objts approach fm S in autos rear vision mirror. Objt passes to left and above vehicle, altitude estimated 1000' above mountainous terrain, 1 mile W. Objt stopped, turned around, orbited about 3 min, above 1000' peaks ahead of observers auto, then slowly descended behind peaks. Descended apparently straight down.		11. COMMENTS Saw plane in rear view mirror while driving along mountain road. Plane came near car and shot flare at about this time and continued circling and disappeared behind mountains. At about same time radiator boiled over and car stopped due to overheating, fan belt was off causing water pump to not function as well as limit generator action while loose causing flickering of car lights. All this plus the alcohol plus the coincidence of the plane and flare created the UFO situation in the observers' mind. Very good investigation of surrounding data by intelligence team.

(1) OBSERVERS TRAVELING ON GRAVEL ROAD NORTH OF FLINTKOTE CORPORATION'S BLUE DIAMOND MINE, 15 STATUTE MILES DUE WEST OF MCCARRAN AIRPORT, LAS VEGAS, NEVADA NOTICED OBJECTS APPROACH FROM SOUTH IN AUTOS REAR VISION MIRROR. OBJECT PASSED TO THE LEFT AND ABOVE VEHICLE, ALTITUDE ESTIMATED 1,000 FT ABOVE MOUNTAINOUS TERRAIN, ONE MILE WEST.

SINCE FAA FLIGHT RECORDS OFFICE CLOSED AT TIME OF THIS REPORT, NECESSITATING SUBSEQUENT INVESTIGATION OF POSSIBLE CIVIL FLYING ACTIVITY IF REQUESTED; USWB AT MCCARRAN AIRPORT ADVISES BALLOON RELEASE AT 0300 HOURS LOCAL (1000Z) BUT NOT ATTRIBUTABLE AS UFO DUE TO NORTHEAST FLIGHT FROM MCCARRAN. NO MILITARY FLYING ACTIVITY IN OR OUT OF NELLIS AFB CAN BE ATTRIBUTED TO SIGHTING.

UFO LANDING AREA, BASED ON OBSERVERS INFORMATION, WAS DETERMINED TO BE IN VICINITY OF THE WATER SPRING AT THE BASE OF SPRING MOUNTAIN. NO SIGNIFICANT BETA/GAMA RADIATION NOTED IN AREA. REPORT DELAYED DUE TO BASE OPERATIONS OVERSIGHT IN PASSING INFO TO DIRECTOR OF INTELLIGENCE EARLIER. SINCE FLYING/METEOROLOGICAL ACTIVITY NOTED AT TIME OF SIGHTING DOES NOT CORRESPOND TO UFO OPERATING AREA DN AHCRACTERISTICS, CONSIDER THIS UFO TO BE A POWERED FLIGHT VEHICLE OF UNKNOWN ORIGIN AND PURPOSE.
