This stationary aspect could be accounted for by a constant relation to the North Star, which also moves. Case considered as insufficient data.

OBJECT WAS FIRST SIGHTED AT 1508Z AND STILL IN
SIGHT AT TIME OF THIS REPORT. ALSO SEEMS TO BE
ANOTHER OBJECT WITH IT WHICH APPEARS TO BE BLACK.

September 21: Honolulu, Hawaii - At 7:05 p.m., M. W. Rasmussen, civil engineer and manufacturer's representative, observed a bright-lighted UFO which sped on a straight course, east to west, above Honolulu harbor. It was visible 30 seconds.
