Your letter of September 30 addressed to the Department of Defense has been referred to the Air Force.

It is not possible to tell you what the objects were which you saw while observing the Sun's corona. It is possible that a combination of factors were involved since we have no other corroborating reports. Perhaps you witnessed a phenomena referred to as Sun Dog's (see writings by Donald Menzel, Director of Harvard Observatory) further compounded by eye strain due to the intensity of the light (even though blocking direct Sun light).

I know that this is not too helpful, but with the information given this is about the best we can do toward helping you solve the mystery. Knowing that you are interested in astronomy, I would like to recommend that you read Flying Saucers by Dr. Menzel. It is filled with interesting cases and provides a great deal of information on astronomical phenomena.
