TO: TD-E (Major Friend)

- 1. The examination of the film has produced these findings.
- a. In addition to the bright ellipse, a similar separate faint image also appears in most frames. This is the only feature that is duplicated in the format.
- b. These images change position within the frame in a uniform manner while maintaining their same position relative to each other.
- c.. The background also changes position within the frame but at a different rate.
- 2. Analysis of the report reveals the following:
- a. The sun was very high and slightly aft of the direction of flight.
- b. The camera was aimed to the left and in a downward manner.

3. The only explanation we can offer is that the images were caused by the reflection of a round window or light within the aircraft. Such reflections on a double pane window yould produce a double image.
