Analysis and Conclusions:

ON 2 JAN 1962, ABOUT 2225 HOURS FROM THE AREA WARPKE / WEST GERMANY, A BRIGHT FLYING OBJECT WAS OBSERVED OVER EAST GERMAN TERRITORY. THE OBJECT OCCASSIONALLY FLASHED RED. NO FLIGHT NOISE WAS REMARKED. DIRECTION OF FLIGHT: W-E, LATER TURNING TO SOUTH, WEST GERMAN TERRITORY NOT VIOLATED.

THIS REPORT CONTAINS INSUFFICIENT INFORMATION TO ALLOW A VALID CONCLUSION, HOWEVER, THE OBJECT WAS PROBABLY AN AIRCRAFT ANTI-COLLISION LIGHT.

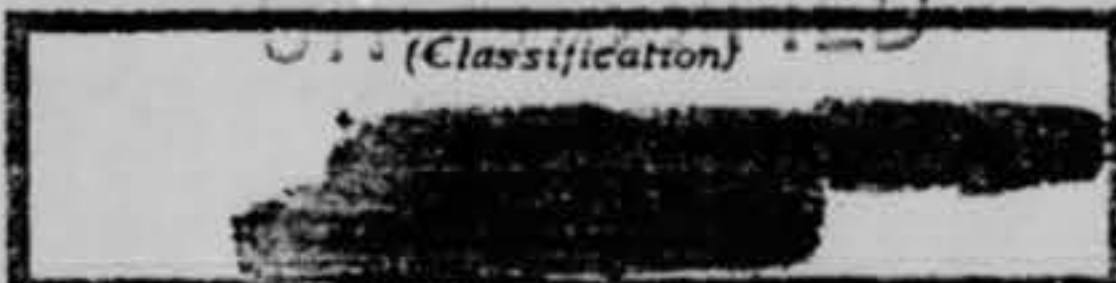

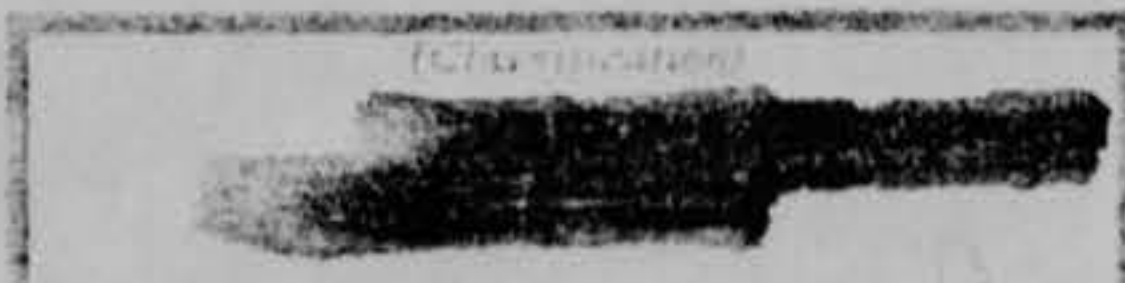
