"ONE OF SPACE AGES MOST HISTORIC MEMENTOS WAS PRESENTED TO SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT IN AN INFORMAL CEREMONY IN OFFICE OF MINISTER FOREIGN AFFAIRS ERIC LOUW THIS MORNING BY U.S. AMBASSADOR JOSEPH C. SATTERTHWATTE.

MEMENTO IS A FRAGMENT OF ATEAS ROCKET WHICH BOOSTED LT. COL. JOHN GLENN, INTO ORBIT FEBRUARY 20 AND LATER FELL NEAR ALIWAL NORTH IN CAPE PROVINCE. ALL FRAGMENTS RECOVERED WERE SENT TO UNITED STATES, FOR ANALYSIS.
