AT 071730Z, LAT 22-40N LONG 125-00E AN OBJECT WAS SIGHTED AT AN ELEVATION OF 10 DEGREES BEARING 005 DEGREES TRUE, TRAVELING IN NORTH NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION, OBJECT HAD BRIGHTNESS OF SECOND MAGNITUDE STAR, VISIBLE 5 MINUTES. OBJECT WAS NOT PICKED UP ON RADAR. OBSERVED BY OOD, JOOD, AND BRIDGE WATCH PERSONNEL. OBJECTS BRIGHTNESS GRADUALLY FADED AND DISAPPEARED BEARING 044 DEGREES TRUE AT AN ALTITUDE OF 5 DEGREES.
