

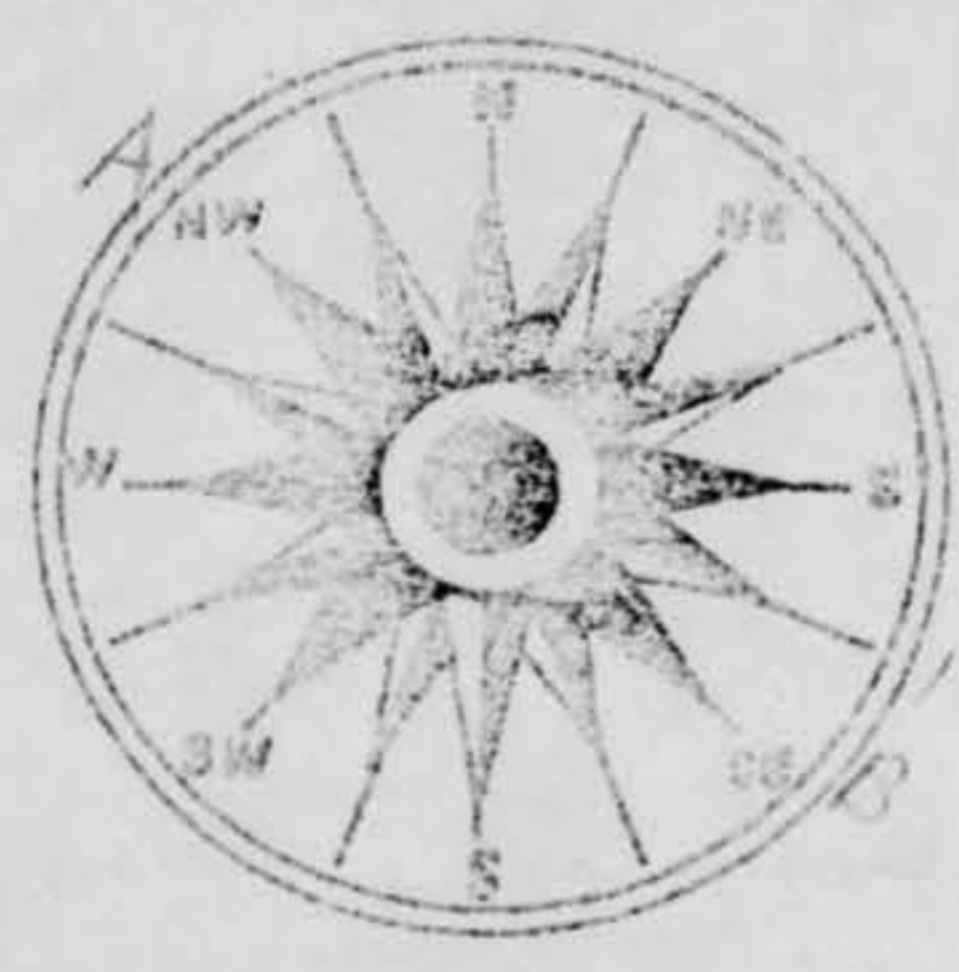
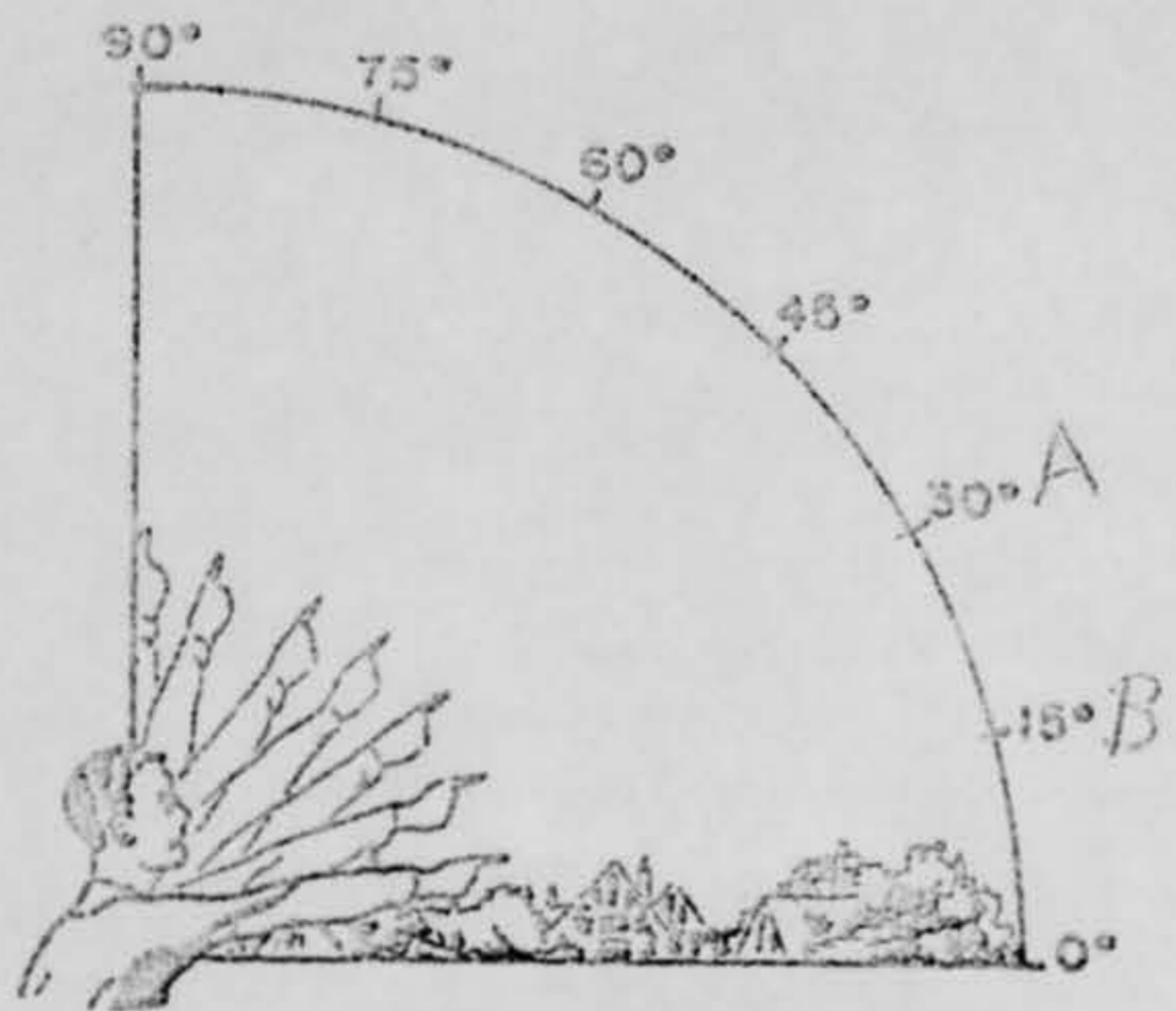

Color bluish grey, sound like planes wings cutting through air. Speed estimated at 1500 mph. Altitude and distance compared to a jet airliner except that speed was 3X as great. Observed from top of building. Object initial observation gave size as basketball. Approached and became size of tire. Witness climbed down ladder and got camera (Polaroid) climbed back up and took 4 shots without giving the necessary 60 second developing time.		11. COMMENTS In all probability the object was an a/c as the speed estimated by the duration, the sound etc. fit with this analysis. Also the other 3 witnesses refuse to corroborate the sighting as anything unusual. report received over one year after sighting and no attempt is being made to investigate this sighting at present. Case carried as insufficient data in view of limited information (Only one of four witnesses report received.)

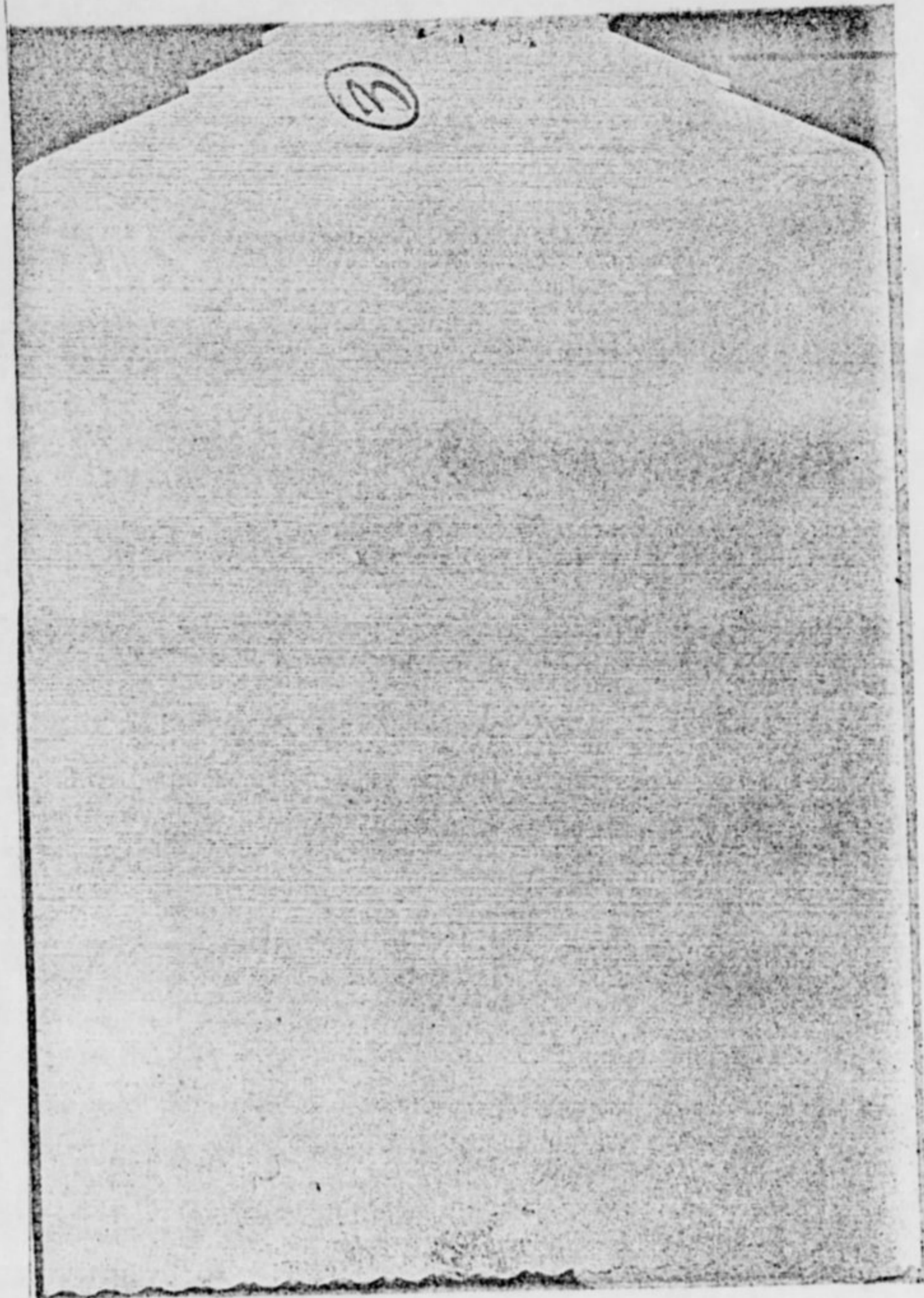
1. The following information is provided to assist you in a reply to [REDACTED] (member of NICAP) to his letter of 25 Jan 64. This letter resulted from previous correspondence to [REDACTED] in which we stated that information provided to him was with the understanding that no additional information would be given unless specifically directed by your office. In your reply to [REDACTED] on 23 Jan 64 you informed him that the Air Force did not have resources allotted to Project Blue Book to answer specific questions from individuals. It is suggested that this statement be made again and [REDACTED] so informed that he will not receive additional information, since he is not considered a member of the press or bona fide researcher. All previous correspondence to him has resulted in additional research and many man hours expended in support of his hobby.

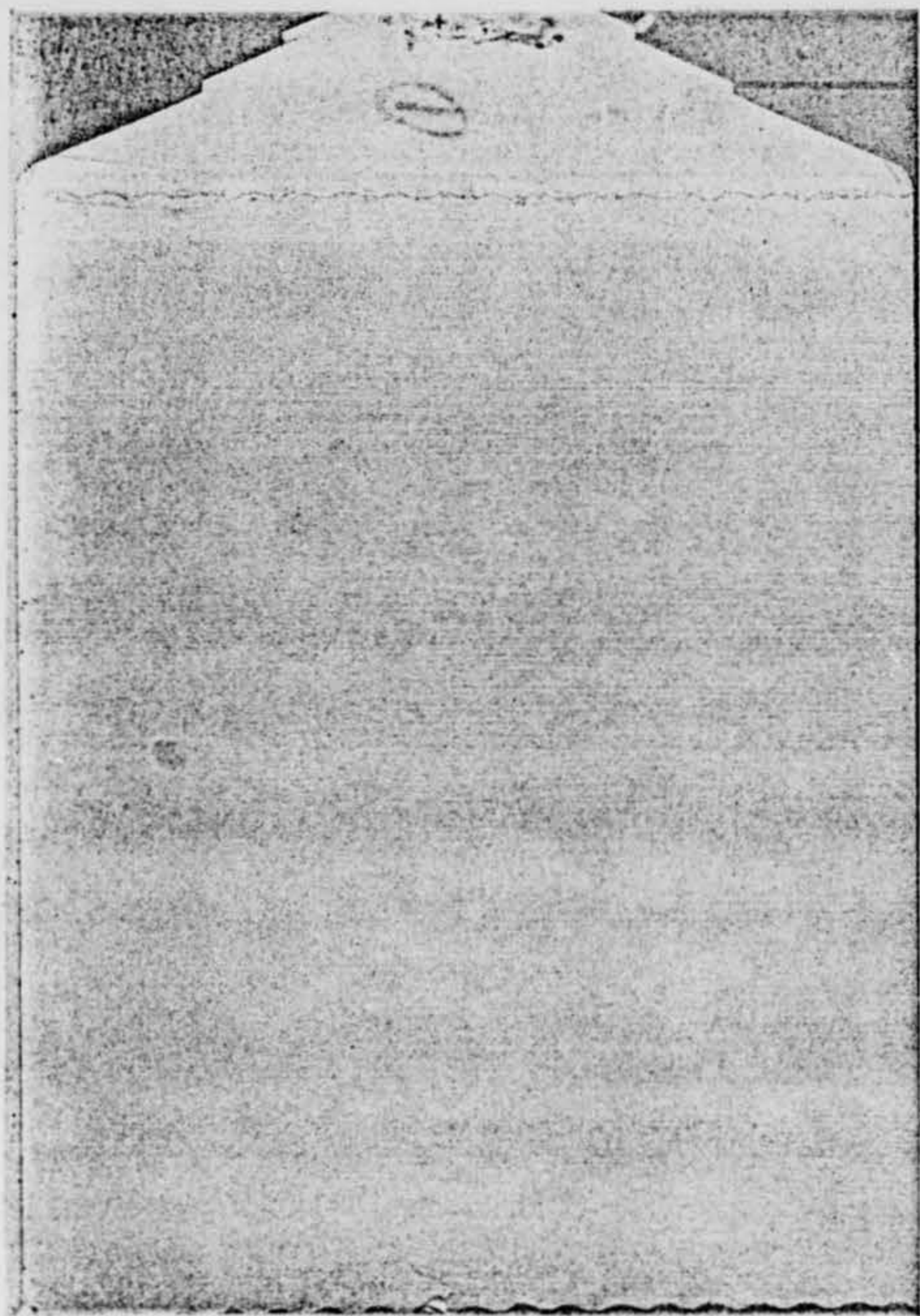
2. The photographs taken on 25 May 62 are obvious hoaxes which any untrained observer would easily note. The four photographs were taken by a Poloroid Camera. The speed of the object indicated by the principle witness, [REDACTED] was estimated at 1500 mph yet the objects show no lateral blurring and are sharply outlined. Also, the witness stated that the photos were taken without giving the necessary 60 second delay in developing time. He stated that he pulled the slide as fast as he could. The photographs indicate at least a 30 second exposure.

3. In view of the inconsistencies by the stated report and the photographs submitted the case has been evaluated as an obvious hoax.

4. The sighting of 1 Nov 62 from Wolburn Massachusetts has been attributed to psychological causes. It will be noted that the observer had 10 minutes in which to summon additional witnesses.

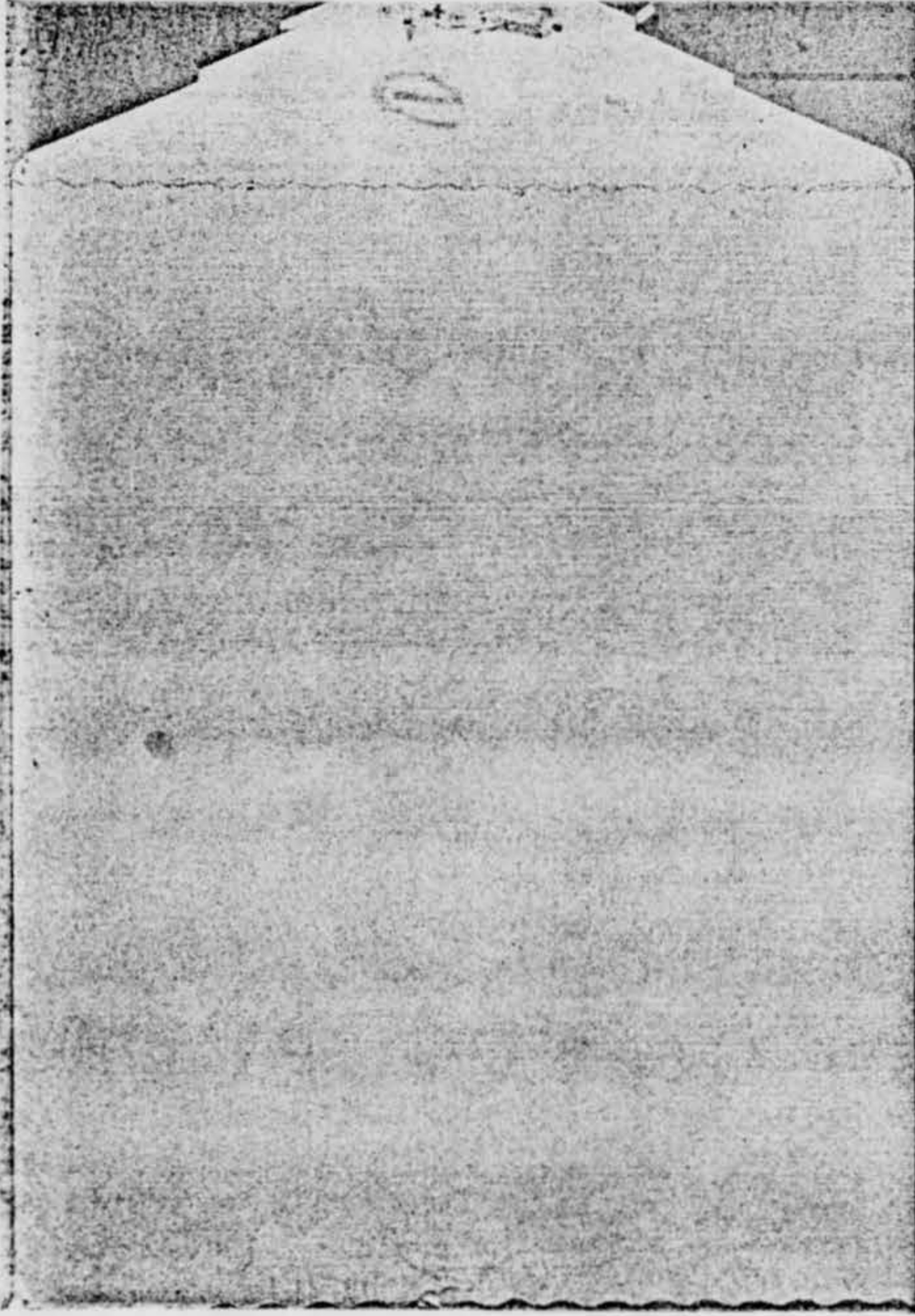

There are many inconsistencies in the report. For example:

a. The object was described as "brighter than a bright sunlight" yet minute details of the alleged object were given.

b. Use of such statements as "It vanished while watching it, faster than my eye could follow it. In the distance straight up".

c. The distance of 2000 ft and the size reported is inconsistent with detail shown.

d. The witness indicated that clicking sound was heard and a small appendage moved in and out of the rear of the object. These statements are also inconsistent with the size and distance of the object from the observer.

5. The Woburn, Massachusetts of 1 Nov 62 and the Burlington, Massachusetts of 25 May 62 sightings were not included on the list supplied to [REDACTED] because they were received subsequent to final review of the 1962 cases. They were evaluated upon receipt as:

a. 1 Nov 62, Woburn, Mass- Other (Psychological Causes)

b. 25 May 62, Burlington, Mass- Insufficient Data - The photos were not received.

Evaluation of the Woburn case remains the same. The evaluation of the Burlington sighting has been changed to other - Hoax.

Dear Major Jacks:

Regarding your recent letter concerning New England 'flying saucer' sightings of 1962 I would like to make the following comments.

First of all, the Nov. 1, 1963 UFO close encounter sighting over South, Mass. that included a long projection from the object and an increase in background radiation above normal, which was checked by SA Civil Defense and myself was not even included in your list at all and this report was mailed to PROJECT BLUEBOOK many months ago (on official Air Force questionnaire also).

The other sightings included photographs taken by a Polaroid Super Camera (sighting reported to Air Force Project Bluebook on official questionnaire) was also investigated by me on May 25, 1962, at Burlington, Mass.

Enclosed are the photographs that were taken during this sighting, numbered in order of how they were taken and viewed by the observers. I would like the Air Force to analyze them for me and return them within 30 days. If I do not receive them by the end of February, 1964 I shall have to request their return through official channels. Hope that you enjoy my other enclosed information. Thanks for your cooperation in these important matters.

This is in reference to your letters of January 25, 1964, and your note of February 9, 1964. The pictures you submitted are returned herewith as per your request.

The photographs are considered obvious hoaxes for the following reasons: the four photographs were taken by a Polaroid Camera. The speed of the object indicated by the principle witness, [REDACTED] was estimated at 1500 mph, yet the objects show no lateral blurring and are sharply outlined. Also, the witness stated that the photos were taken without giving the necessary 60 second delay in developing time. He stated that he pulled the slide as fast as he could. The photographs indicate at least a 30 second exposure. In view of the inconsistencies in the stated report and the photographs submitted, it is considered that this is a hoax.

As previously stated, in our letter of January 23, 1964, the Air Force does not allot resources to Project Blue Book to engage in lengthy discourse on specific UFO questions except to the bona fide news media or to scientific researchers. If you can submit proof of accreditation to either of these categories, further consideration will be given to answering your detailed questions.

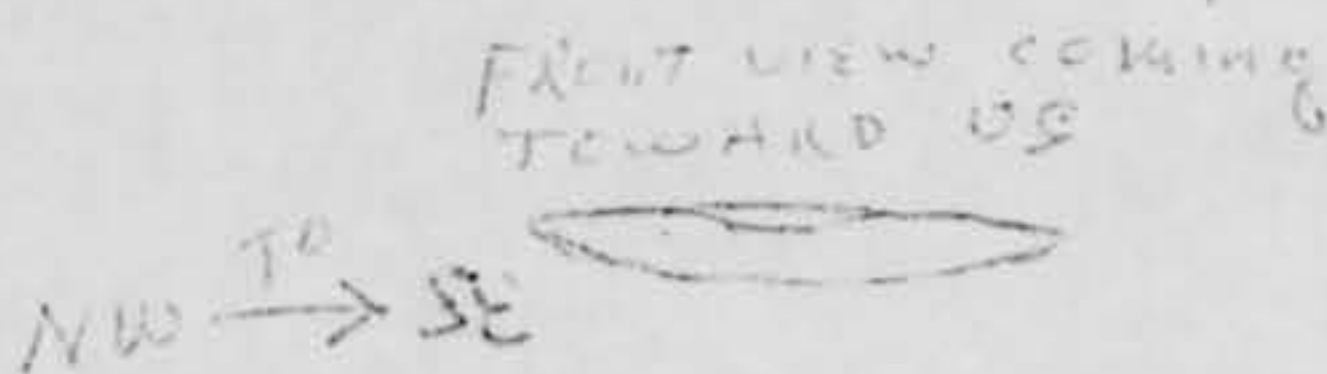
