PORT OF AIR CRAFT NOSE INCREASING IN BRIGHTNESS AND
UNCUSUALLY LONG FLAMING TAIL. OBJECT APPEARED TO BE
COMING DOWN FROM A NORTHERLY DIRECTION ABOUT THE
SPEED OF A FALLING STAR. OBJECT WAS VERY BRIGHT AND
THEN BURNED OUT AND THE SECOND BLACK OBJECT
APPEARED TO THE TAIL OF IT. OBSERVATION WAS FOR
3 TO 5 SECONDS. NO EVALUATION.
