Gentlemen:

Please assist me in a problem I encountered on the evening of July 6, 1962. I have been told to contact you by the AF Reserve unit in this area.

While swimming in Lake Michigan at a beach near Saugatuck, Michigan I saw an object in the sky which I at first took to be a meteor. This object which seemed to be very distant, although it was very bright, was of two colors. It was red on the lead portion and white on the rear portion. It moved very steadily out of sight in a westernly direction. I first sighted this object at 11:51 PM EST. I saw it again at 12:04 AM and 12:32 AM. There were tall trees behind me so that the object's location at the time of these sightings was approximately overhead. The object was visible for approximately one (1) minute at each sighting before it went out of sight. It covered an arc of apprx. 25 - 30 degrees in that time.


