At 131540Z August an unidentified flying object was observed over Managua by ARMA. Passing from northwest to southeast, object first appeared in distance as a falling star. Moving rapidly at undetermined speed, without noise, at low but undetermined altitude, object appeared to follow horizontal course. When overhead, body unidentifiable but appeared as glow with luminous trail which appeared to be chemical pro-

pellant. Object not identified by local qualified sources.
