On September 2, 1962 I saw an UFO in the sky north of Jackson. About 50,000 miles above the earth. For a while it hovered in the same spot. Then it came down about 10,000 ft. It stayed there 5 minutes and 23 seconds. Then it ~~was~~ moved south a little. It came down another 10,000 ft. stopped and stayed there about 6 minutes, came down to about 15,000 ft. above the ground stopped and stayed there 10 minutes & some seconds then a cloud covered it for a minute.
