1. SINGLE OBJECT SIZE OF FIRST MAGNITUDE STAR, WHITE IN COLOR, OBSERVED AT 090445Z.
2. ATTENTION OF OBSERVERS, CREW OF WV-2 145936, ATTRACTED BY MOVEMENT OF WHITE OBJECT THROUGH BELT OF ORION. OBJECT OBSERVED INITIALLY AT ELEVATION 35 DEGREES, AZIMUTH 210 DEGREES MAGNETIC. OBJECT IN SIGHT FOUR MINUTES BEFORE FADING INTO SUNRISE PASSING POLLUX, ELEVATION 35 DEGREES, AZIMUTH 150 DEGREES MAGNETIC.
3. OBSERVED VISUALLY WITHOUT OPTICAL AIDS BY FOUR CREW MEMBERS. ACFT POSITION AT TIME OF SIGHTING 6426N 2933W, COURSE 236 DEGREES MAGNETIC, TAS 190 KNOTS, ALTITUDE 8000 FT. WEATHER CLEAR, WIND 340 DEGREES TRUE 32 KNOTS. LIGHT CONDITIONS EARLY DAWN.
