To Whom it may concern,

Last Friday, Sept 14th, I was visiting with my daughter on S.W. 54th St. of this city. My grandchildren who were playing outside, called my attention to an object in the sky. With difficulty I observed the object which seemed to be a plane maneuver about fifty or sixty thousand feet up. There was no vapor trail. I tried to reach Tinker Field and the radio stations here. It was about five P.M. and no one answered. Finally I got the newspaper on the phone and some one said that they would investigate it. I could not be definite about the height. But the late afternoon sun brought out the features to resemble a plane. I could not hear its motor.
