THIS AIRMAN WAS VERY VAGUE ON MANY DETAILS CONCERNING THIS SIGHTING. HE SEEMED VERY UNSURE OF THE SIZE AND DIMENSIONS OF THE OBJECT AND THE DISTANCE IT WAS FROM HIM. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE C-46 FROM WHITEMAN AFB TO TINKER AFB, TAKING OFF AT 0124L COULD HAVE BEEN WHAT A2C [REDACTED] SAW. THERE WAS A BRIGHT FULL MOON THAT NIGHT WHICH MAY HAVE REFLECTED OFF THE AIRCRAFT. A2C [REDACTED] WAS ABOUT SEVEN MILES FROM THE BASE AT THE TIME OF THE SIGHTING. TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE, A2C [REDACTED] WAS THE ONLY PERSON WHO OBSERVED THIS UFO. L. NONE.
