QUOTE 171119Z SIGHTED WHILE AT ANCHOR IN MISSISSIPPI RIVER ONE
QUARTER MILE BELOW DONALDSONVILLE, LA FERRY ON RIGHT DESCENDING
BANK. A CELESTIAL PHENOMENA APPEARING OVER EASTERN HORIZON
BEARING 090 DEGS FROM ANCHORED POSIT, APPEARED IN BRILLIANT WHITE
GLOW OF CIRCULAR SHAPE AT 090 DEGS, DESCENDED TO APPROX 30 DEGS,
AND APPEARED TO MAKE RAGGED CIRCULAR COURSE LEAVING HUGE WHITE
VAPOR TRAILS AND DISAPPEARED ON INCLINE COURSE OF APPROX 50 DEGS,
