5. LENGTH OF OBSERVATION 10 minutes	11. BRIEF SUMMARY AND ANALYSIS  Four boy scouts watched an oblong shaped object about the size of a passenger plane. Two different object were observed. First observed was a single object hovering in the sky and all at once it began to move very swiftly in a SW direction. The object then stopped all of a sudden and descended rapidly and vertically down behind the horizon. Another object, identical to the first, appeared and did the same thing as the first. Two minutes after the second one disappeared over the horizon, one of them came back and hovered again, then moved slightly to the west and set down out of sight.  The sighting occurred in an area of high intensity student aircraft activity. The description is consistent with that of an aircraft observation.

B. DESCRIPTION OF COURSE:

4. "WE FIRST NOTICED A SINGLE OBLONG SHAPED OBJECT  
HOVERING IN THE SKY ALL AT ONCE WE SAW IT MOVE  
VERY SWIFTLY AND HORIZONTALLY IN A SOUTHWEST DIRECTION.  
IT THEN STOPPED ABRUPTLY, WITHOUT SLOWING DOWN, AND  
DESCENDED RAPIDLY AND VERTICALLY DOWN BEHINE THE HORIZON.  
A FEW MINUTES LATER, ANOTHER OBJECT, IDENTICAL TO THE  
FIRST, APPEARED AND DID EXACTLY THE SAME THING. ABOUT  
TWO MINUTES AFTER THE SECOND ONE DISAPPEARED OVER THE  
HORIZON, ONE OF THEM CAME BACK UP AND HOVERED AGAIN,  
THEN MOVED SLIGHTLY TO THE WEST AND SET DOWN OUT OF  
SIGHT.
