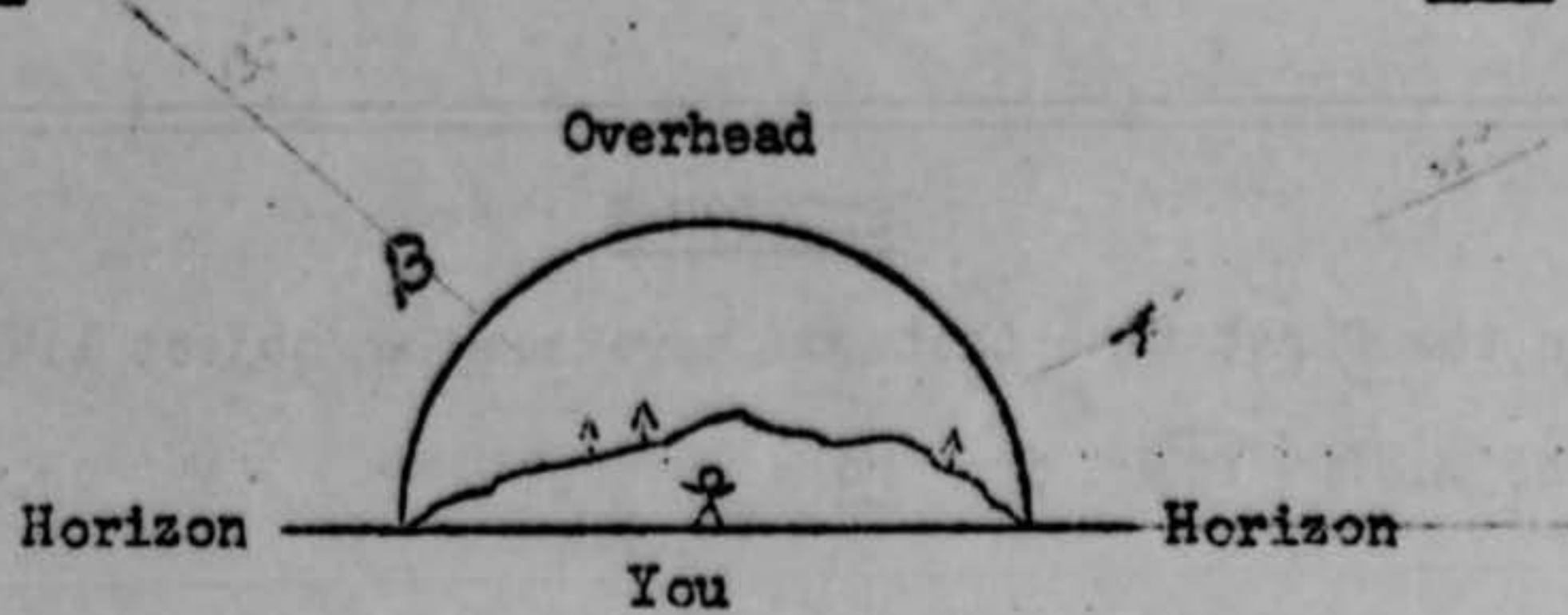

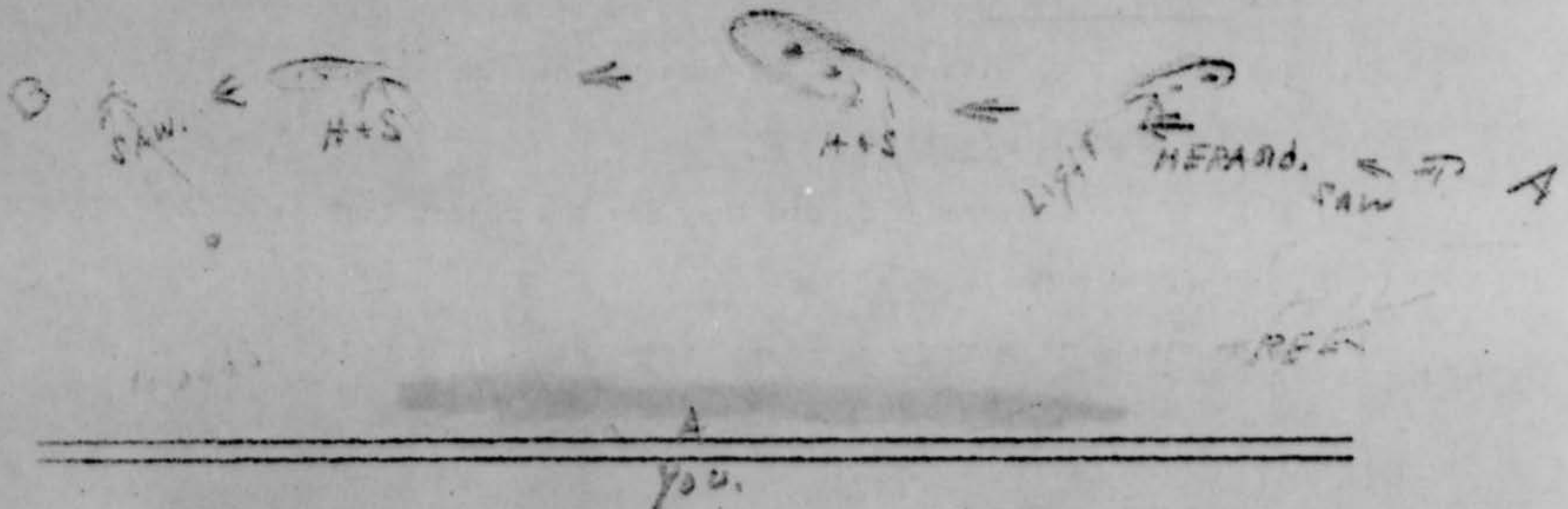

Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED] Pa.,  
[REDACTED], reported seeing an unidentified flying object at 2347Z on 9 September.

The object was described as a "bright white light". The observers also reported that wings were visible, although no tail or other features of an aircraft could be seen. Its speed was described as "faster than an airplane", its heading ENE, and it appeared to be higher than commercial aircraft which pass over the area. The observers reported hearing a "rumble" which sounded something "like a jet" during part of the observation.

Weather at the time was clear with fifteen miles visibility.

Although the observers claim that the object did not look like any aircraft they had ever seen, their descriptions leave little doubt that the object was in fact an aircraft, probably a jet.

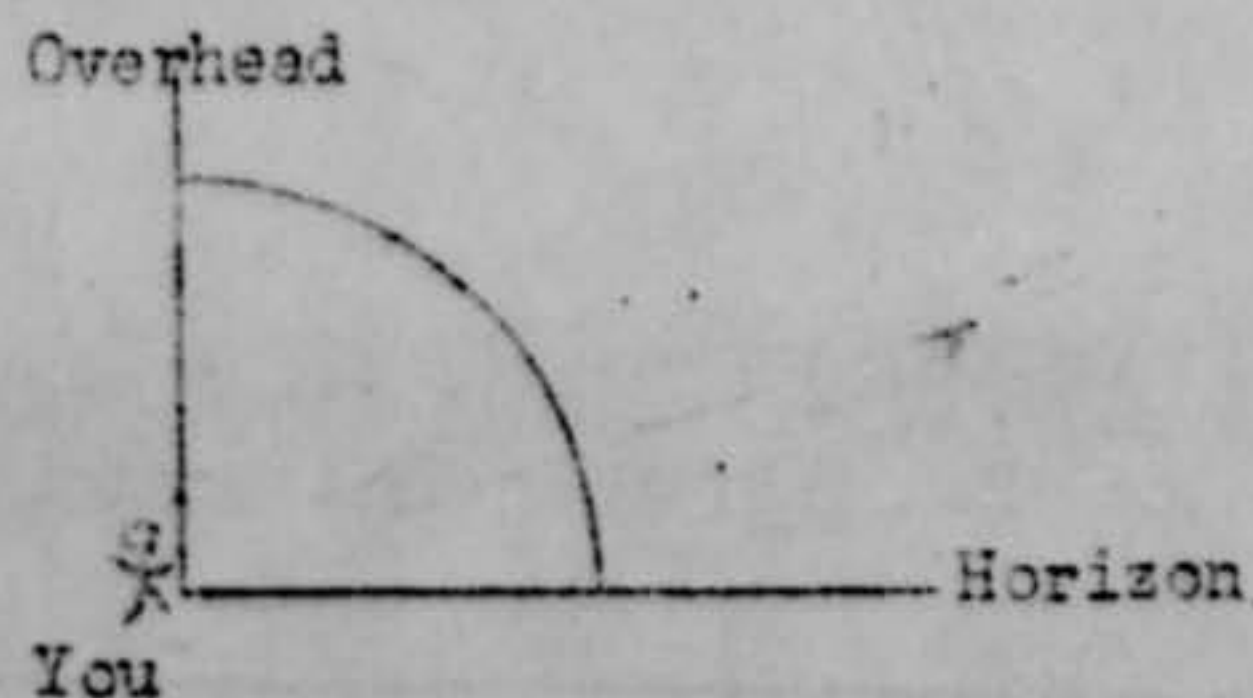
