This is in response to your conversation on March 1, 1968 with Major Huppertz of the Senate Liaison Office concerning the analysis of UFO photographs.

If you will complete the attached questionnaire and mail it in the inclosed envelope, our technical people at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base will perhaps be able to investigate your sighting.

In order to make an evaluation of your photograph, it will be necessary for you to provide Wright-Patterson Air Force Base with your original negative, (or photograph if Polaroid) together with the following information:

Type and make of camera used
Type, focal length, and make of lens
Brand and type of film
Lens opening used; that is, "F" stop
Filters used, if any
Was camera on tripod or solid stand
Was "panning" used
Exact direction camera was point with relation to true North, and its angle with respect to the ground

If you cannot supply all of the above information, at least furnish the type of camera, the smallest and largest "f" stops, and shutter speed readings. This information is essential for an accurate analysis of your photograph.
