- (a) shape, 3 dots of light in triangle, a large one and 2 smaller ones
- (b) size compared to a known object held 1 arm length, something  $\frac{1}{8}$  in diameter
- (c) color, red for the large dot and the small one on the left, green for the small dot on the right.
- (d) number, it could have been object on 3 in formation
- (e) formation, in 3, V formation
- (f) any discernible features or details, the three light blinked on and off
- (g) tail, trail or exhaust, none
- (h) sound, none
- (i) other peculiar or unusual features none

## 2. Description of course of object(s):

- (a) what called the observer to the object(s), I was looking for satellite and saw the object(s)
- (b) angle of elevation and azimuth of the object(s), from  $170^\circ$  to  $100^\circ$   
azimuth of the object(s) when first sighted,  $170^\circ$
