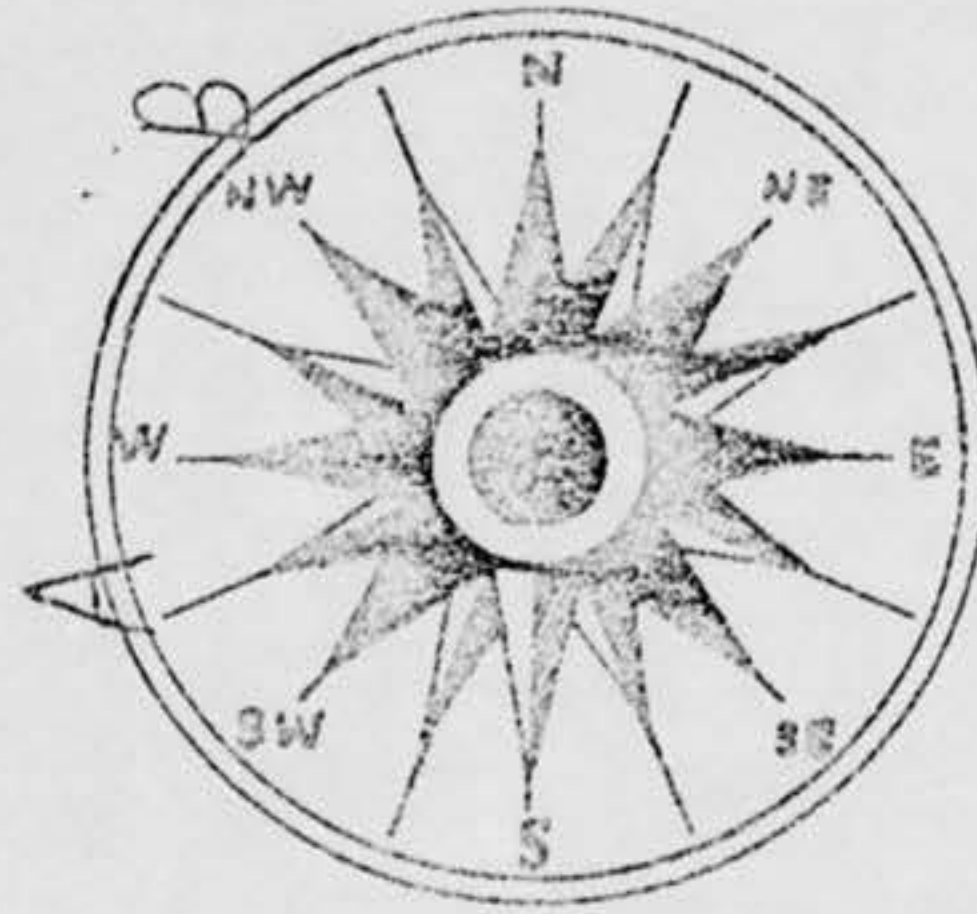
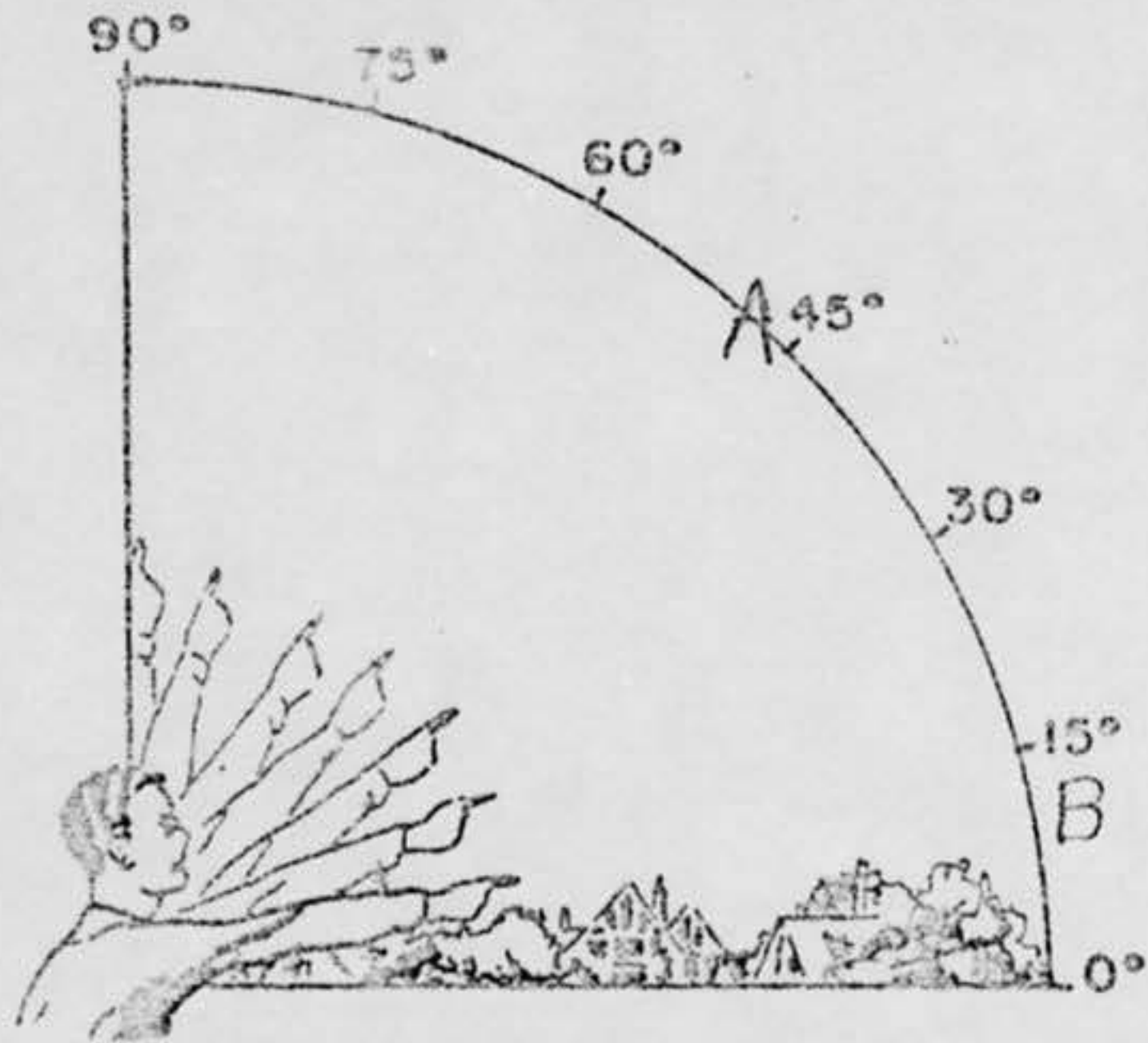

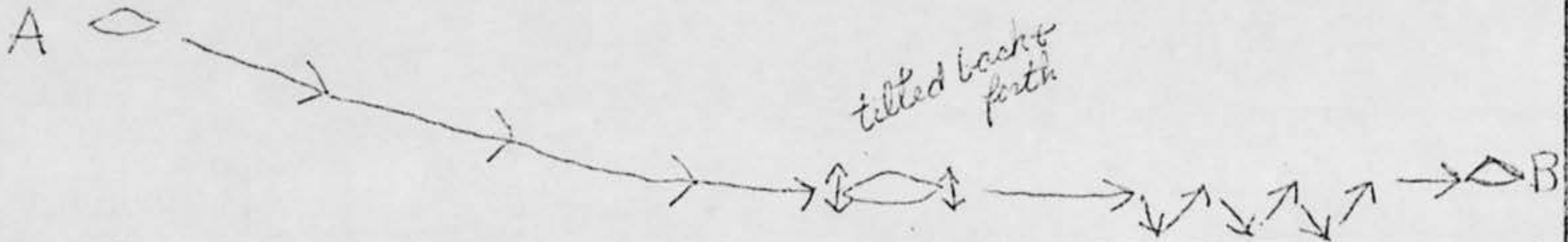

Dear Sirs:

My name is [REDACTED] I live
one mile west of Green Lake, Wisconsin.

On April 27, 1967, at about 10
p.m. [REDACTED] and
I were going to [REDACTED] house which
is one mile west and one mile north
of Green Lake. We went west a mile
and then turned north on the road
to his house. I noticed a bright
red object in the western sky. It was
near the ground and changing from
red to white to orange. It was moving

very slowly to the north and very near the ground. The sky was very clear with no clouds or no wind.

We quickly drove down to ~~the~~ house to get his binoculars. His house is in a small valley that runs east to west which is open.

Mr. Fenner and the three of us watched the object which was about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile away. It hovered over the ground and tilted from side to side very slowly and was moving north towards a small wooded hill. Through the binoculars the object was very clear and distinct. It looked like the one I have enclosed in this letter. It also was about the same size when viewed with the binoculars.

The object was changed from red

to orange to white all the time. It tilted once so we could see its bottom which was a bluish color or glow.

When it got near the woods it stopped. Then it tilted toward the north and went down into the woods. It flooded the area where it was with white light. Then it would come out again and move north and then did the same thing again. The lighted area of the woods could be seen very easily without binoculars.

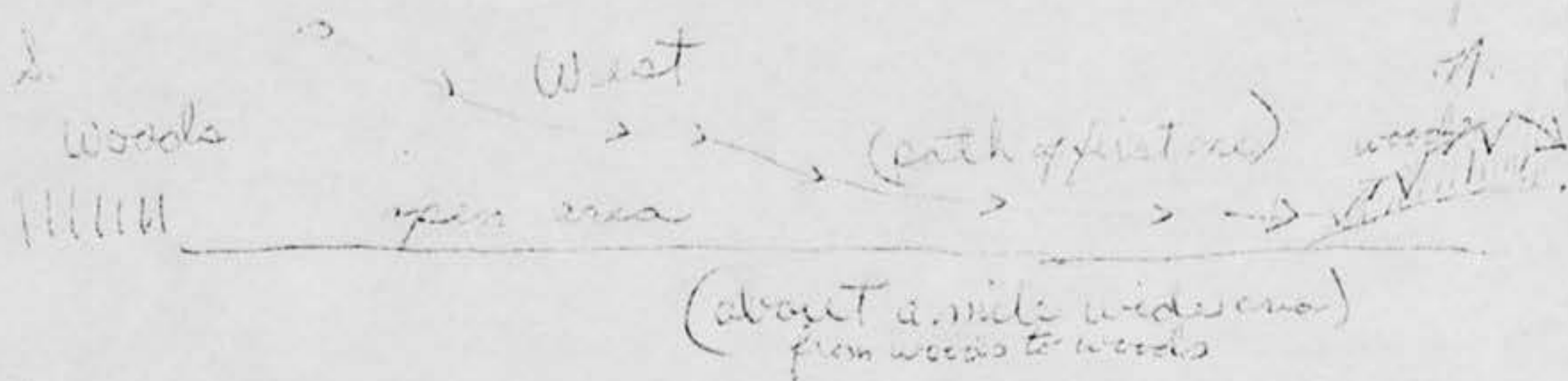
It finally came up out of the woods again and went over the hill. We got in my car and went north to the top of a hill after we got enough nerve. We could see it still traveling north at tree top level but it was now quite aways away from us. Finally it disappeared from sight. Once when we first saw it the object

came our way and got too close
for comfort so we ran back to the
house but other than that it kept
going north. We watched it for
about 15 minutes. There was no
moon at the times we saw the object

I could hardly believe what we
had seen. We could see it so clearly
it was unbelievable. I never thought
I would ever see anything like it

We told a few people but they
wouldn't believe us so we just
dropped it. Then last night we
saw the same thing traveling
west, higher and farther away but
we could still see it with the
binoculars which are 7x50. I
called up Ed Wells and his
father and they came out to
~~to verify it.~~ to verify it.

This is a close looking of the one we saw. When it turned red the top was bright red and the middle orange. the bottom had a bluish glow. It was the same shape. Please answer.



We watched it untill we lost it
from sight. It was about 20 minutes
because it was moving very slowly
and again changing colors but was
redder on top. We saw this at about
10 o'clock (pm) also and we just
happened to notice it in the sky

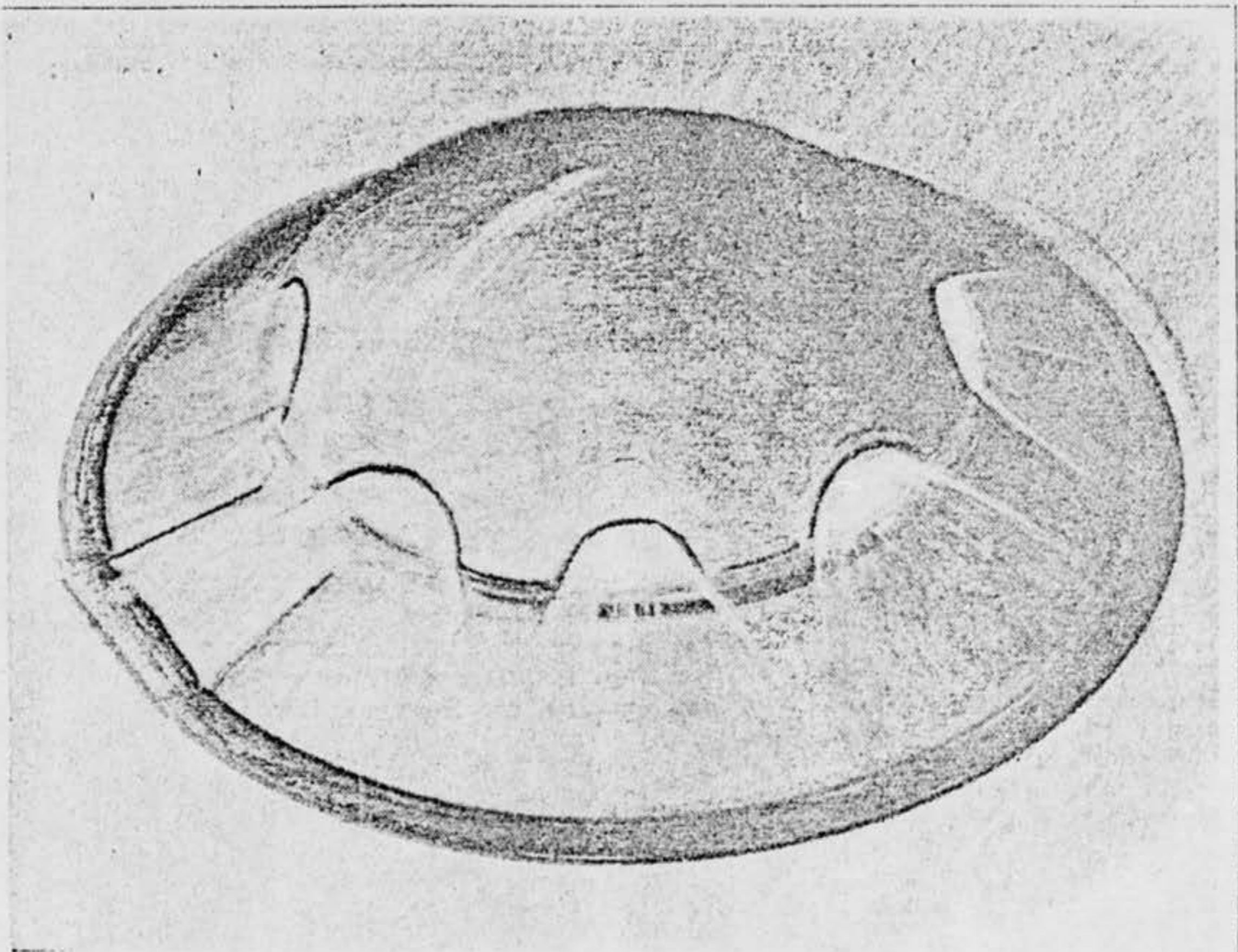
I know you gentlemen are
