




 going to a friend's house, and bowling at Sierra L.
 I was at the time walking home between the hill and
 Fairgrounds and my house. It was very cold outside and
 I wasn't really watching what was going on around
 me. While I was walking home I heard something (this was
 but I think it was a dog) that made me suddenly look around.
 I kept on going for a few seconds and I then heard a faintly
 piercing sound (like that of a police car but higher in pitch).
 When the sound became louder I looked both ways down
 the road for a police car or something to that effect.
 Before this I had always been interested in space and
 I believe now more than ever, hold a strong
 belief that there are beings from other planets and that they
 have both landed & tried to make contact with the earth.
 I am not a saucer nut and don't believe in every saucer
 sighting there has been. Well as I was telling you before
 my interruption of the main story I was looking
 to see if there was a police car around. At this time
 I could hear nothing else but that strange high


The bottom had no lights that I could see,


On the back it had two lights on the upper third. It also had dim yellowish lights rectangular in shape in the middle portion. These dimmer lights seemed to follow a pattern, that is when one would go off the next would go on. (The pattern was rotated very quickly)

The craft was descending constantly lower and I just stood there and watched it. Then again it had passed over the school its piercing vibrations of sound stayed slowly and then dwindled in a low-pitch hum. I suddenly got the urge to run and then it came I did so. It seemed to be looking for a certain place to set down and by this time I was looking behind part of the wall at what I think was the left wing. (It seemed at that particular moment no cars came past nor were on the road.) (I now think this was unusual) It moved on about 150 ft. (estimated again) from the ground and I followed it until it was off the school property, between the fields there are narrow borders of various sizes through which it hid in, and went along, while following the object. 


Above is a ~~one~~ sketch of what the legs of the

the craft were now more brightly shining.
The steady hum of the craft stopped abruptly,
but the lights dimmed just a little bit, at

Admiral brought many souvenirs from his voyage and brought
it back with him without any exchange of word
or gift. I do not know what the divers -
and they came without touch and taste like guests, but it
was very surprising to see how much of value
they had to offer. They did not mind
telling the price of their goods. I am not sure if
these men of whom there talking, the same who
had been mentioned in my advertisement will
have come down and bought the gifts I have

The next comes very thin & about three inches that they seemed to defy the law of gravity. The beings simply put them in a certain place and they stayed not moving an inch. Now I was shivering not only from the cold but also from my brain. I was on the verge of panic but I kept telling myself to be calm. Then I heard the noise of crunching ice and thought at first it was help. I wanted to yell out to whoever it was but I'm glad I didn't. Out of the partially lighted field came a man dressed in what looked like hunting clothes. He walked up to one of them and started to talk to him. 2 others went over also and I think 3 others guarded the area. This time it was different. Those beings were talking with their lips & vocal chords. I could see there mouths move and barking heard part of what the outsider said. After a very short time of a minute or more he left. I watched him till he was out of sight and then turned my concentration back to the space craft. Why did the man contact them and did he say he will not discuss with anyone except what officials with authority.

As I was watching them I must have made a sound that caught their attention (though I don't remember any sound I made other than a steady shivering). One of them looked at another and pointed near to where I was. I jumped up on an impulse and began to run, but every step I made, it seemed I would fall down. Almost as quickly as I had started, one of them had grabbed my by part of the neck. (I later discovered that where I was hit, there was a red mark.)

It started to bring me back to the ship and I remember coughing a few times to try to breath. At the same time I felt an vibrating ache in the area of the upper part of the back of my neck. I remember struggling to get free but it was to no avail. The beings hands felt cold and clammy. It had dragged me almost all the way to the space craft when another came to help. Then I noticed their hands. Their joints in the phalanges were shaped differently and there faces had a peculiar effect on me. Just as the other one was about to help they looked at each other & dropped me in the snow. It was more against it than them anything else that had happened. They could do anything they wished with me but they just dropped me. After dropping me they hurried into the shaft and ascended to the inside of the craft. Stripped by force I picked myself up and ran in a direction I still do not know. After a few seconds of running I came back to my senses and ran home as fast as I could. Almost home I stopped running and caught my breath until I was able to breath almost normally. Then I entered the house and went into the kitchen and almost fainted. For a reason, probably curiosity, I went back. When I arrived at the spot the beings were hurriedly collecting the spherical objects and then entered the rectangular shaft. Almost as soon as the shaft had disappeared into the craft a beam started. The lights that were very dim then were now brightly shining and the pitch of the beam was increasing rapidly. The craft ascended a little, and the tripod like legs slowly disappeared into the bottom. Then it rose about 200 ft. above the ground and quickly went out of sight among trees as fast as it had come. I walked home (ran part of the way) and didn't get hardly any sleep that night. That was



1. This report of UFO Investigation forwarded for your information and file.
2. The UFO was allegedly observed by a Timothy R. Johnson on the evening of 5 February 1967. Investigation since that date has been inclusive. The lad, age 14, maintains his story, but no other evidence has been uncovered to verify it.
3. Reported Description of the Object:
 - a. Shape - Hamburger shape.
 - b. Size - Estimated 70 feet in diameter, 30 feet high.
 - c. Color - Platinum with black band.
 - d. Number - One

 - g. Sound - High pitched (Similar to but higher than a siren).
 - h. Other - See attached statement and drawing for detailed description (Atch 1 and 2).



d. Sore spot on observer's neck, (claimed as a radiation burn). Spot was observed by the investigator. The spot was on the nape of the neck at the collar line. It appeared the size and shape of a man's thumbprint. At the time of observence there was no evidence of an open sore. The spot appeared to be a large pimple or small boil that had no core and appeared to be in the healing stage.

e. Landing Site. An investigation of the alleged landing site was conducted in the presence of the observer. No physical evidence of landing was noticed; no marks on the ground, no burned areas or any sign of disturbance. Survey of the area with an AN/PDR-27 Radiac Instrument produced only normal radiation background indication.

f. Observer Statement: The observer's personal written statement (Atch #1) and drawing of the UFO (Atch #2) are attached. His initial formal report is also attached (Atch #3).

14. This report has been delayed in the hope that further proof might be advanced by the observer either to verify or, inadvertently, to negate his earlier statements. During several telephonic discussions since the initial visit and inquiries, nothing further has been offered that can prove or disprove the validity of his statements.

15. Conclusions: It is the undersigned's opinion that:

- a. The story is too pat, well remembered, and systematically presented to have actually occurred to a scared 14 year old boy;
- b. Some incident did occur on that evening that was not fully understood by Timothy, he was worried about it, either because of his own implication or implied danger to himself and he developed the story as an excuse;
- c. The possibility of a deliberate hoax cannot be definitely eliminated although the observer's continued interest and his forthright attitude do tend to show an innocent motivation; and finally;
- d. The lack of physical evidence and absence of further reports from other individuals in this rather populous area tend to belie his statements.


