REPORT OF UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT

3. PERTINENT FACTS. Bourbon is a small community on Highway 66, approximately 75 miles southwest of St. Louis, Missouri. The area of the sightings is approximately 2 and 1/2 miles northwest of Highway 66, and is a rural area with homes separated by distances of a few hundred yards to one mile. Areas around the homes have been cleared and are maintained as lawns and/or open fields. Most of the remaining area is in woodland.

a. Most of the sightings have occurred at the home of Mrs. [REDACTED]. The first sighting occurred on 8 February 1967, and sightings have reoccurred almost nightly since that time until the present. Generally, the objects appear as a reddish glowing light the size of a large grapefruit, originating over the trees in her backyard. They sometimes come out of the woodland itself, and as they approach the house can be seen to increase in light intensity, changing to a brilliant white light which bathes the area in light as though an outside house-light had been turned on. The lights hover near the ground as if searching for something and emit a fan shaped sweeping white light. On occasion the objects touch the ground and give off sparks (described as like popcorn shooting into space). The objects wander back and forth at low level, sometimes drifting off into the trees or over them, and again shooting straight up and disappearing.

b. The lights have distinct form, although a solid vehicle has not been observed. Sometimes three lights appear as a triangle, approximately five feet separating each light. On other occasions a single light has been seen as an elongated object with legs

approximately three feet long protruding from all sides except toward the back of the object. The legs can be withdrawn and extended. The legs had white lights on the end of each one. This object emitted a whirring noise whenever it moved, and the noise stopped whenever it hovered. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that she received a "beep" signal on her TV whenever the objects were in the area. Also, the furnace made a roaring noise and acted erratically. She claimed that many people in the area had complained of unusual furnace troubles.

c. On one occasion there was a strong odor of orange peel in the outside area when the object had been sighted.

d. The objects appear regardless of the weather, being seen on clear nights as well as during rain and sleet storms. They can be seen shortly after dark, and sometimes stay throughout the night.

e. Mrs. [REDACTED] dog seems to sense the objects, and barks whenever they are in the vicinity.

f. Mrs. [REDACTED] attends an invalid husband and is fearful of going outside to investigate; therefore, has never attempted to approach the objects.

g. There is a garden approximately 100 yards from Mrs. [REDACTED] home containing rhubarb, and she claims that one one occasion the leaves were torn and burned, and some stalks pulled out of the ground.

h. She has counted as many as a dozen lights at one time hovering and flitting about her yard, in the garden and in the trees. She has observed them with binoculars through the windows, but this did not make them more distinct in form.

i. Mrs. [REDACTED] has been told that the area is rich in magnesium deposits, and feels that "some foreign government is gathering the mineral, and our government should be looking into this matter and saving it for their own use."

j. Mrs. ██████████ is a sister of Mrs. ██████████ and has seen the objects on three occasions. She describes the lights essentially as Mrs. ██████████ did. Her observations were sometime in March and lasted up to 3 and 1/2 hours at a sighting. Otherwise much of her comment was based on what her sister had told her. She did emphasize that the dogs hair stood on end when the objects approached.

k. Mrs. ██████████ has two boys, ages approximately 5 and 7 years, who went out to dispose of the garbage one evening at dusk. They came racing back to the house, stating that a luminous round object had come down over them and then zoomed off. It flared up and became quite bright. There was no noise at the time, but the dogs started barking. No physical signs could be found in the area later. This incident occurred before word had gotten around that Mrs. ██████████ had also seen the objects. Later on Mrs. ██████████ also saw lights similar to those described by Mrs. ██████████. They were visible across a field in her backyard, and were in the woodland approximately one-fourth mile, behind the house. Mrs. ██████████'s property and that of Mrs. Hunter adjoin with approximately one mile separating the houses.

l. The Reverend ██████████ visited Mrs. ██████████ home approximately two months ago, having heard of the sightings. He, too, saw the same type of single lights, which became quite bright as they hovered over the garden area. They moved back and forth, at a height of 20 feet down to 6 feet. They changed color three times, changing from red to a greenish color and then orange. The lights became diffused when in the orange stage, covering an area of approximately 25 feet with the light. He observed the lights for 15 minutes and described them as phenomenal. The Reverend ██████████ has known Mr. ██████████ for approximately six months, and although not her pastor does visit her home periodically. He described her as a very honest, straightforward person, not tending to exaggerate, and having seen the lights himself must agree with her report.

m. Mr. ██████████ was a bit reticent, and had to be drawn out, but did confirm that he had seen the lights on two occasions in Mrs. ██████████ backyard. His home is approximately 150 yards down the road from Mrs. ██████████ property.

n. The W [redacted] live about a mile from Mrs. [redacted] on the opposite side of the road, and about 1/2 mile off the highway. There is a junkyard across from the entrance to their side road which can be seen from their property. About a month ago they had guests one evening, and as they were leaving at 9:30 p.m. they commented on the bright car headlights at the junkyard. After the guests left the [redacted] noted the lights still there and they realized it could not be a car, as the lights moved up and down. They would dim and then get bright again. They watched the lights for approximately 1/2 hour and have not seen them since.


4. COMMENTS:

a. There is no doubt that these people have seen something, and are not letting their imagination play tricks on them.

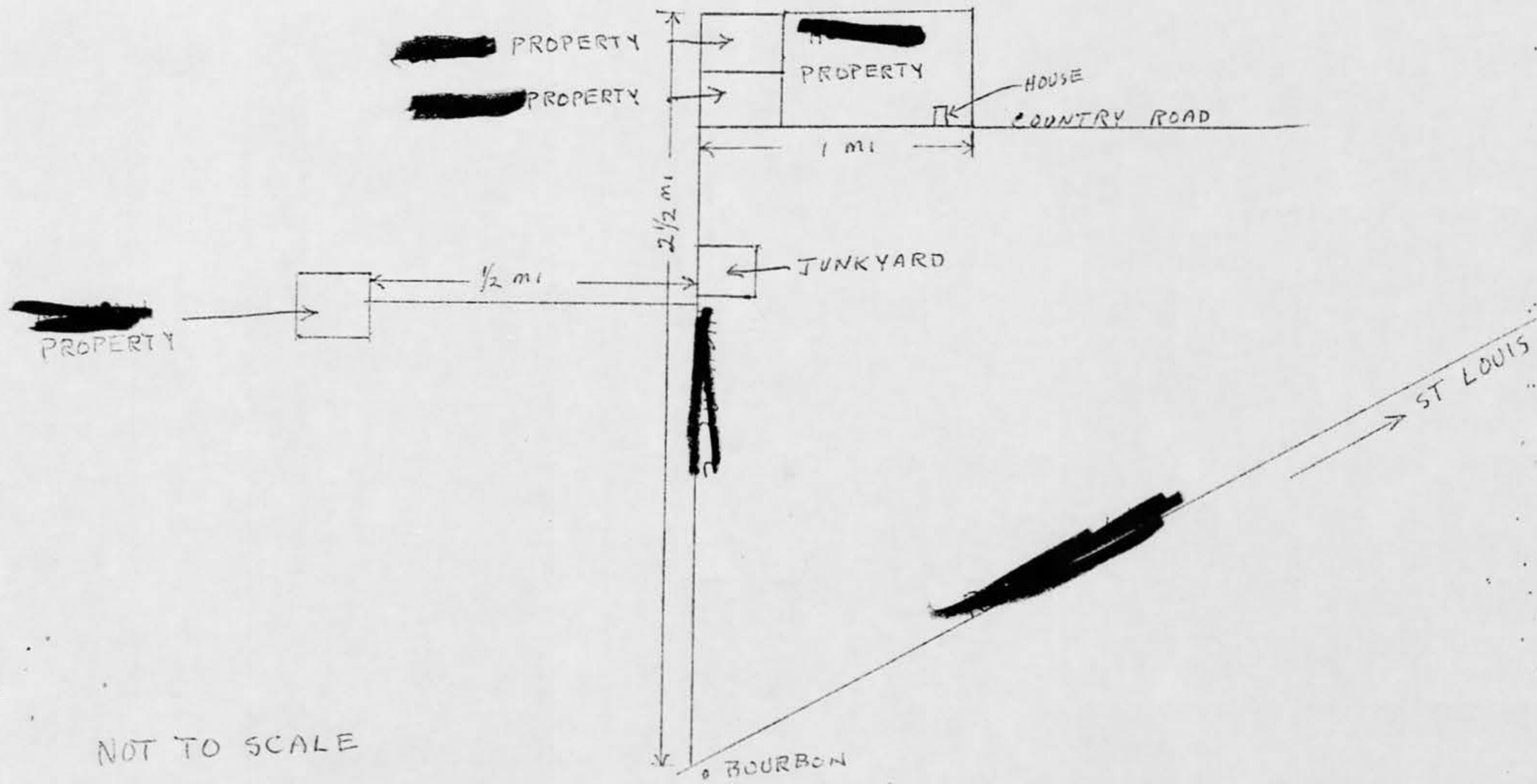
b. The area is in the country, with no street lights. The nearest airport is at Sullivan, Missouri, six miles distant, which is a small community and has no night time air traffic as far as is known. There are no radio or television towers in the area. The lights could not be sightings of planets as they move around, and were at various elevations. Initially, the sightings were made without knowledge that other people had had similar experiences. Although there are farm ponds throughout the area, the land is generally at same elevation and is dry and rocky. This, therefore, should rule out swamp gas. Fireflies are also ruled out as these sightings occurred initially in rather cold weather.

c. I was impressed by Mrs. [redacted]'s sincerity and interest in this matter. While most of the people I spoke to were elderly, they were not senile. They were all very rational, and were curious as to what this unusual phenomena might be. I feel that it is especially significant that a minister would confirm these sightings, and could vouch for Mrs. [redacted] character.

1. Reference correspondence from Mrs. [REDACTED] concerning the observations of numerous unidentified flying objects since February 8, 1967.
2. There are two air refueling tracks in the area, plus a high speed low level training route; however, since air activity records are normally destroyed after thirty days, we are unable to check those records for possible air activity.
3. It does not appear that satellites, balloons, or ground lights, were responsible for the sightings. The lights were reported to have been seen in all directions and under all types of weather conditions.
4. The witness did state that she had contacted the State Highway Patrol concerning her observations. Contact was made with the State Highway Patrol Station, Rolla, Missouri. An incident report revealed that a Trooper Shelton went to visit the witness on 6 March 1967 after she had reported observing unusual objects. During his visit, the witness pointed out to Trooper Shelton eight light configurations which she claimed to be UFOs. These lights were evaluated as aircraft lights, by the trooper, and gave the appearance of lights coming from the woods.
5. Mrs. [REDACTED] has sighted a number of lights on different occasions, and it is impossible to definitely identify each of her observations because of the lack of specific dates and times. There is no way to check aerial activity without specific times. There is also no question that Mrs. [REDACTED] has been seeing lights and that she is motivated by patriotism when reporting her sightings; however, there is no indication that they are hostile and she should not become alarmed. Mrs. [REDACTED] lives in the path of very heavy military and commercial air activity and she will continue to observe various light configurations in the vicinity of her home during the hours of darkness.

Dear Mr. [REDACTED]

We refer to your inquiry in behalf of Mrs. [REDACTED] regarding her unidentified flying object (UFO) sightings.

Within the Department of Defense the Air Force has the responsibility of investigating UFOs reported to it and determining whether or not these objects constitute a threat to our national security. This program, Project Blue Book, is explained in the attached brochure.

Blue Book personnel at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base inform me they have not received any UFO reports from Mrs. Brune's area. However, since February 1, 1967, six reports have been received from your State. These were from Kirksville, Holland, Kansas City, and Springfield. Two of the reports have been evaluated as the planet Venus. Venus, with a stellar magnitude at this time of year of -3.4, is the brightest astronomical body in the western sky. The other reports have been evaluated as possible aircraft performing various maneuvers, refueling missions, etc.

I have inclosed an FTD Form 164 which is used in officially reporting a sighting to the Air Force. If Mrs. [REDACTED] will complete this form, an attempt will be made to evaluate the sightings in her area. The form should be mailed to TDET/UFO, Headquarters FTD (AFSC), Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio 45433.

It has been a pleasure to be of assistance to you in this matter.



Dear Sir:

We have been bothered with UFOs since February 8, 1967, to my knowledge. Possibly they were here before but do to a new dog, I know of them since then.

They are here every night rain, shine, or sleet. They come at 7 and stay some times as late as 5 in the morning. I sent my report to Nicap and ask some of my neighbors including our postman to do the same which they said they would. Its real aggravating when they fly right over the house and flood it with that piercing white light. They ran across our front lawn ground level but I wasn't brave enough to go out and find out but neither was my company of three.

Nicap said they were trying to get Congress or I should say "seek open Congressional hearings." I hope this can be done as it is real hard to see this every night, knowing they are drawing something from the ground and are kept in such complete darkness about these things. I understand that they have a metal we can't produce. If some one could watch them work from side to side, back & forth then up & down they could probably figure out how & why as they tell me our country here is full of magnesium.

We had so many on the ground and in the sky you just wonder how there can be so many and our radar can't pick them up it sure seems to me that we're not so safe. I can't seem to get help from the highway patrol. I guess they would be at a loss as they shoot up so fast your eyes can't follow them. It or they came down close to the Hunter children (6 children to be exact) and they describe it as large round with smaller round things on top with red & piercing white lights.

Hope you can give me some answers as I just don't know where to turn.

Please don't just brush this off as it is true and I don't lie believe me.

Rev. & Mrs. [redacted] and their daughter were here last night, they can tell you. They found their back car window broke as from heat as there were no marks from stones or anything

They had their car sitting in the yard. They have so many times shot out that white light, its not so funny. Hope you can help me some how. Mr. & Mrs. [REDACTED] of Bourbon and their son was here when I counted 16 and you can ask them as that was one night when it went across our lawn. It's not our quiet country any more. They are so different than anything you ever seen. Will send a stamped envelope, hoping to hear some news, as I'm indeed serious and I don't need the publicity.



Thank you so much for answering my letter. This to me alone would make me vote as I believe you do care what concerns your voters. I was told by a neighbor you would answer as you did answer her. I filled out forms for Ni-Cpa, and then the Air Force. The Air Force did not answer but our sky was full of planes for a week the first of April and the UFOs are at a minimum now. My trouble here is that I don't have a camera. My husband had a stroke and is paralyzed on his right side, and we are on his social security as I'm not yet 62 so they tell me in order to film these things I'd have to get a good camera & a telescopic lens. Well wish I could but I can't right now. Mr. and Mrs. [redacted] & their son was here when they crossed the front of our house so I'll send them all stamped addressed envelopes as I'm sure they will send you the details. The [redacted] children 17 yrs, 14 yrs., and 4 younger seen it and can describe it. I've seen this so many ways its puzzling me as I did not believe in them either until I seen them and know there has to be some explanation. The only one now I can believe as they had a program on Channel 11 at 8 p.m. Tuesday, one expert said a piece of metal was found and its of high grade magnesium and they tell me Bourbon is setting on lots of it.

When they are ground level they work back & forth & side to side, then up and down. All the time shooting out this piercing white light, it goes like this  off and on.

I watched it one night when I couldn't sleep until 2:30 a.m. Then it was there at 4 or 4:20 until 5 a.m. then I finally slept.

I have Mr. & Mrs. [redacted], Mrs. [redacted] and her 3 children, Mr. & Mrs. [redacted], Mrs. [redacted]s children, Mrs. [redacted] and several from St. Louis that seen them. Then there were quite a few men that I don't have their address but works in

Dear Sir:

My sister Mrs. [REDACTED] asked me to write and tell you our experience with the UFO.

We were at my sisters home on highway C in Bourbon, Mo. on Tuesday March 7th. I looked out the window at 6:50 p.m. and here was this big orange object in the sky. I called my sister and my husband. We watched, it was moving towards us. My sister went to the phone called her next door neighbor about 2 city blocks away. She told her to look out the back window it was coming in. She had just told her this and it was gone. It was just like it had vanished. Later in the evening, we saw it again. It was like a bright star. We had to leave and come back to St. Louis. They later came down on the ground after we left and stayed until 2 a.m.

Then 2 weeks later we went out again. It was a cloudy day so we missed it coming in but we did see six on the ground. They move from place to place. This night they had a very loud hum.

I didn't sleep after I saw this, was worried about my sister. She and her husband who has had a stroke are alone out there.

There has been quite a few people that has seen this thing.

I called the Highway Patrol. They told me they had reports from Rolla but none at Bourbon. All they did was drive by.

Then I called the airport in St. Louis. They told me to call Scott Air Force Base. This I did and did I ever get a run around. A man answered you have the wrong dept. Call the same number but ask for this dept. I told him it was toll and asked him to transfer the call. "I'll try." I was connected with the second dept a man answered, you have to talk to Mr. [REDACTED] and he isn't in. Call back. I told him to have him call me back. Oh! I think he is in the next office. Hold on. This I did, so another man answered. He listened to my story, then he told me to report it to the field that is nearest to her home which is Sedalia, Mo.

Then I got mad, told him my sister was 70 miles west of St. Louis, that Sedalia is much, much farther as I visited relatives many times at Sedalia, so Scott Air Force Base was the closest one. I can't do a thing for you, so this is the way this ended.

I called KSD-TV in St. Louis. This was too far from St. Louis yet one of their men was in Texas covering something.

It doesn't seem that no one is interested at all. All they would have had to do is spend an evening or two and they would have seen it.

For a month they were out there most every night. They still come, but not as often as they have been.

This has been going on almost 3 months, you would sure think someone would be interested enough to check in to it.

1. On March 5, 1967, Troop I Rolla advised reporting officer that they had received a letter from a Mrs. [redacted] who lives about two and one-half miles northwest of Bourbon, Missouri, on Route "C". She stated in the letter that she had been seeing lights in the woods behind her house and across the road and she seemed to think that they were unidentified flying objects.
2. Reporting officer contacted Mrs. [redacted] the afternoon of March 5, 1967, and she talked for sometime about the lights. She showed this officer where they had been seen and just what they did. She stated the first time she saw them they landed in the woods behind her house. She stated that there was one about the size of a dinner plate and after the one landed several smaller ones would leave it. The small ones were about the size of a baseball. The small ones would then go back to the large one and they would leave. The first time they were seen was February 8, 1967, and she stated she had seen them almost every night since. She also stated that several other people had seen them, including the children of [redacted] who live directly behind her. This officer contacted the [redacted] family and talked with the six children ranging from five to seventeen years old. They stated they were carrying out some trash one afternoon late and saw this object about the size of a car coming towards them from out of the sky. They all dropped their trash and ran into the house. They have not seen any more.
3. The night of March 6, 1967, this officer went back to the home of Mrs. Brune and observed the area for about two hours. During this time officer observed eight airplanes, all flying from east to west or west to east. They have flashing red, green and white lights. Mrs. [redacted] pointed to one and said, "There is one now."
4. It is the opinion of this officer that Mrs. [redacted] lives in a flight path and what she is seeing is airplanes. When the airplanes are off some distance, they appear to be coming through the woods. Mrs. [redacted] is getting up in years and since she has been watching this for so long, this officer feels that her imagination is contributing to some of the things she sees.

Comments:

From the majority of the descriptions it is difficult to determine exactly what (if only one object) was responsible for the sightings. The witnesses have seen strange lights continually since the first of Feb 67; however, no specific dates and times are available except the 8th of Feb. 67. The general descriptions of the objects are not consistent with that of an aircraft observation, since the lights were reported to be quite low near the ground. The witness did report that the lights appeared to come from the woods. There are two air refueling tracks in the area, plus a high speed low level training route. It does not appear that satellites were responsible for the sightings. The lights were reported to be seen in all directions. Also the lights have been seen in all weather conditions. State Trooper Shelton had the prime witness point out 8 UFOs to him on 6 March 67. The trooper said the lights were nothing more than aircraft. These aircraft would come over the woods giving the appearance of lights coming up from the woods.

As mentioned above it is not clear at all as to what was seen on a specific date. Thus, it is extremely difficult to reach a positive identification of the lights. Since there was a lack of definite dates, and the information available does not lend itself to reaching a positive conclusion the case is being carried as insufficient data for evaluation.

On March 5, 1967, Troop I Rolla advised reporting officer that they had received a letter from a Mrs. [REDACTED] who lives about two and one-half miles northwest of Bourbon, Missouri, on Route "C". She stated in the letter that she had been seeing lights in the woods behind her house and across the road and she seemed to think that they were unidentified flying objects.
2. Reporting officer contacted Mrs. [REDACTED] the afternoon of March 5, 1967, and she talked for sometime about the lights. She showed this officer where they had been seen and just what they did. She stated the first time she saw them they landed in the woods behind her house. She stated that there was one about the size of a dinner plate and after the one landed several smaller ones would leave it. The small ones were about the size of a baseball. The small ones would then go back to the large one and they would leave. The first time they were seen was February 8, 1967, and she stated she had seen them almost every night since. She also stated that several other people had seen them, including the children of [REDACTED] who live directly behind her. This officer contacted the [REDACTED] family and talked with the six children ranging from five to seventeen years old. They stated they were carrying out some trash one afternoon late and saw this object about the size of a car coming towards them from out of the sky. They all dropped their trash and ran into the house. They have not seen any more.
3. The night of March 6, 1967, this officer went back to the home of Mr. [REDACTED] and observed the area for about two hours. During this time officer observed eight airplanes, all flying from east to west or west to east. They have flashing red, green and white lights. Mrs. [REDACTED] pointed to one and said, "There is one now."
4. It is the opinion of this officer that Mrs. [REDACTED] lives in a flight path and what she is seeing is airplanes. When the airplanes are off some distance, they appear to be coming through the woods. Mrs. [REDACTED] is getting up in years and since she has been watching this for so long, this officer feels that her imagination is contributing to some of the things she sees.

Contact was made with Mr. McPherson (638-3612- Autövon). He said that he visited the area on May 1967 to gather facts concerning the case in question. The witnesses could not furnish any definite dates other than that the objects(lights) have been seen continually since the first of Feb. The lights were always quite low to the ground. The lights would float around the ground and at times appear in all directions. The alleged burnt leaves were examined. It was felt that the leaves had been damaged from frost. The nearest airport of any size is at St Louis. The lights were always quite low thus they would probably not appear on radar. Mr. McPherson said that he did not know of any additional sightings from the area.

7 June 67

Contact was made with the State Highway Patrol, Rolla, Missouri (314/364-1215). It was revealed that Trooper Shelton went to visit the prime witness on 6 March 67. The witness pointed out to Shelton 8 aircraft which she said were UFOs. These aircraft would come over the woods giving the appearance of lights coming up from the woods. A incident report will be forwarded to the Project Blue Book office as soon as possible.

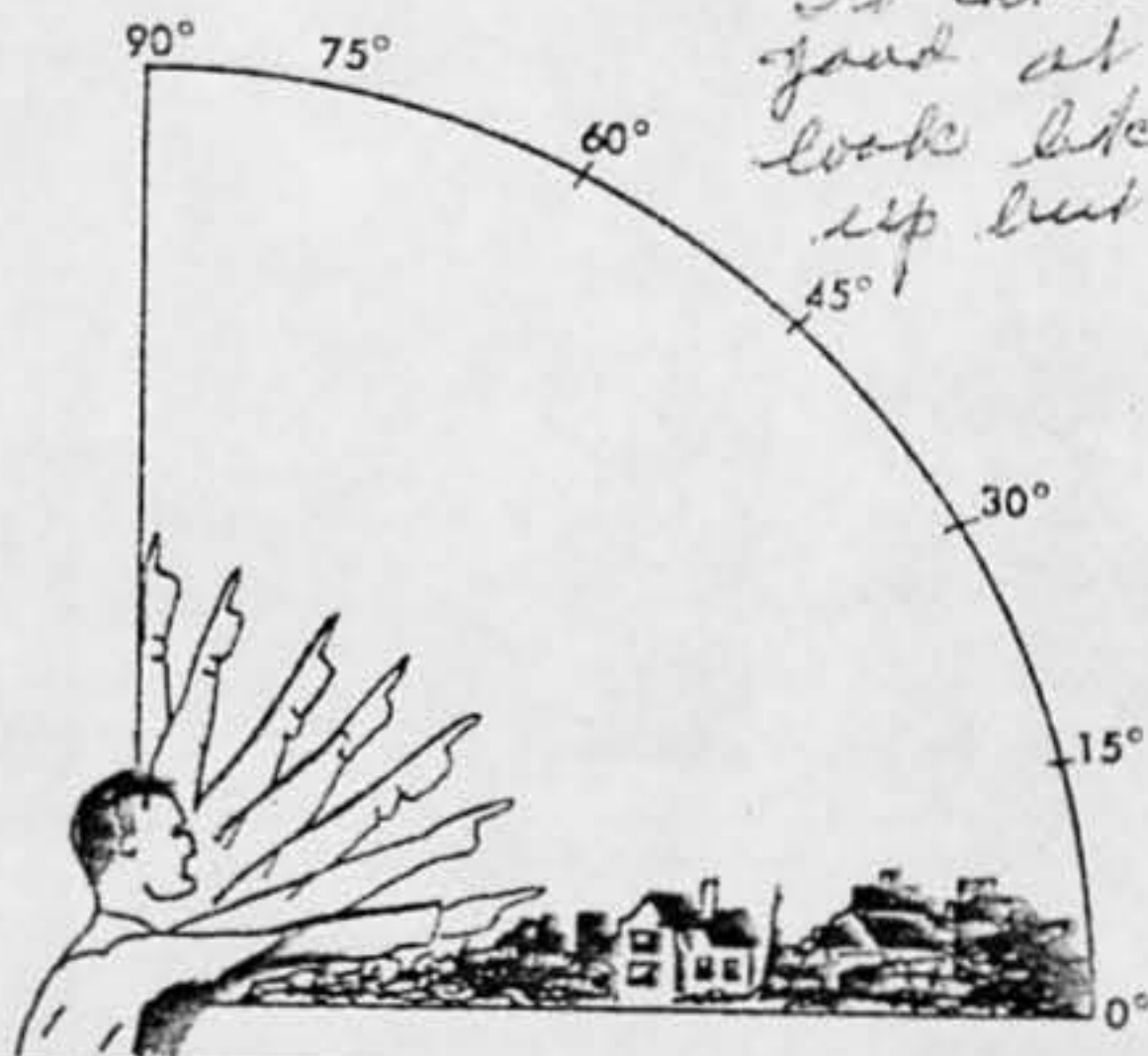

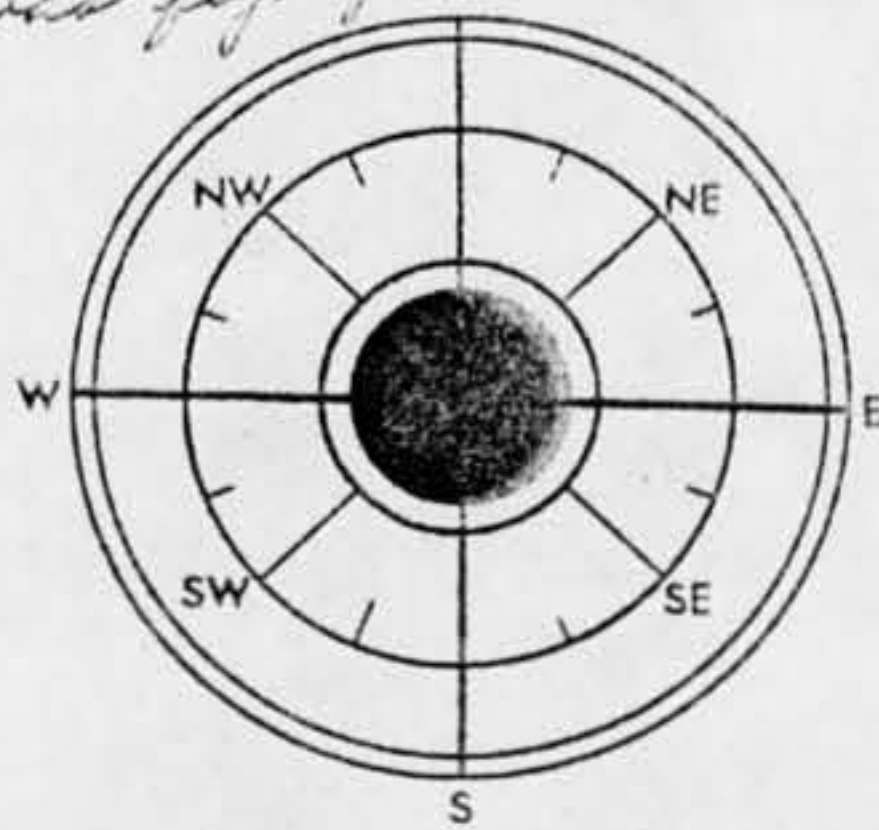

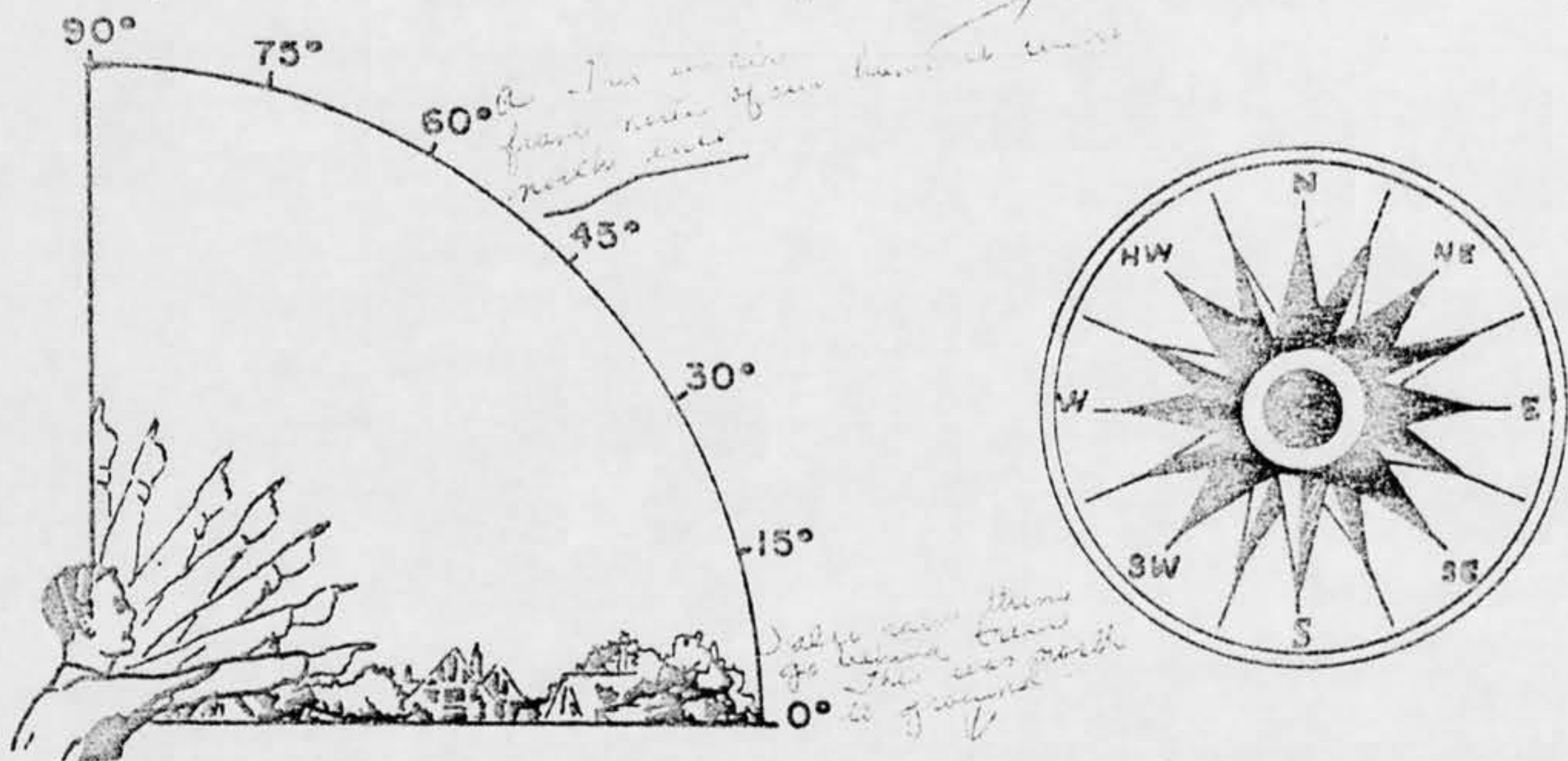
