CAUSES HEART ATTACK

Witnesses See 'Wolfman' Running Loose In Lawton

LAWTON (AP) — Lawton police are looking for a "wolfman" seen on four different occasions by different witnesses; one of whom suffered a heart attack as a result of the sighting.

The creature was sighted by at least four persons or groups of people Friday and Saturday night in separate parts of west Lawton.

Donald Childs, 35, suffered a heart attack Saturday night after he saw the creature in his front yard on its hands and feet, trying to drink water out of an empty homemade fish pond, police officer Clancy Williams said.

Williams said Childs described the creature as "tall, with a lot of hair all over his face, and dressed in an indescribable manner."

Childs then suffered the heart attack, Williams said, and was released Sunday in good condition from a Lawton hospital.

Other witnesses said it appeared the creature was wearing pants which were far too small for him.

The sightings began Friday night, Lawton police said.

Police received the first report from passersby in west Lawton who saw something apparently wearing a mask and resembling an ape. Witnesses said the creature was running down the street, dodging cars, hiding behind bushes and then running again, police officer Harry Ezell said.

It was 20 minutes later, Ezell said, that a man five blocks from the first sighting reported seeing the creature.

"He told me he saw the thing when he opened the window curtain about 11:15 p.m. He thought it was all a practical joke because the subject was perched on the railing. It looked like

some monkey or ape. He thought it was a joke until it turned its head and looked at him, then jumped off its perch on the second floor railing onto the ground 17 feet below," Ezell said.

"The man told me the person ran from the area on all four, something like an ape or monkey would. He described it was wearing only pants which covered his leg to near his knee, as if it had outgrown the pants. He described it as having a horribly distorted face as if it had been in a fire, and it had hair all over its face, upper parts of the body and lower parts of its legs."

Fifteen minutes later, a group of Ft. Sill soldiers at a grocery store three blocks from the last sighting reported being scared by something resembling the other descriptions.

Then on Saturday night, Childs saw the creature and suffered the heart attack.

Maj. Clarence Hill, commander of the police patrol division, alerted Lawton patrolmen Monday night to watch for the wolfman. "It's watchful waiting," Hill said today.

Police tried to get footprints of the creature but said the ground was too hard.

For many generations B.B. (Before Berkeley), undergraduates reacted to campus stress in ways that became part of the American college tradition. They cheered the school teams, they played poker by the hour, they got drunk on Saturday night, and—most important of all—they engaged in practical jokes. Such pranks aren't relevant today, but then they weren't relevant yesterday either. They merely served as respites from the academic grind.

For sheer inventiveness and resourcefulness, it would be difficult to find practical jokes of greater merit than those produced by students at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in the early 1950s. These included such familiar pranks as taking a car apart and reassembling it on top of a building or in a student's room. Occasionally an immense weather balloon would be inflated—with water—in somebody's room.

Many memorable practical jokes were worked successfully by a group of MIT scholars who rode about in a vintage black limousine. On a trip from New York to Boston, the five occupants of the limousine wore gas masks. When the car pulled up to a toll booth, the driver opened his window slightly and stuck out a cane to the end of which was fastened a lump of chewing gum holding the coin.

In a variation, the driver would extend an artificial arm and the toll taker would be left holding the coin—and the arm.

There is a bus stop at Mattapan Circle in Boston where, during rush hour, many people queue up. One day the commuters were joined by a young man dressed completely in black who stood reading a newspaper a slight distance from the queue. Suddenly a black limousine pulled up and a rear window was rolled down. Out of the window came a long length of stove pipe

aimed at the man in the black. As the bewildered commuters watched, a large cloud of white, chemical smoke exploded out of the pipe. The man in black grabbed his throat and dropped to the sidewalk.

The doors of the limousine opened and two young men, also in black and wearing gas masks, emerged to pick up the victim and carry him to the car. The limousine then sped away.

The MIT pranksters thought this one up to see if people were civically conscious enough to call the police. But alas nobody wanted to get involved. It was only after the charade was acted out a sixth time that a witness called the cops.

Such little games are pretty much a part of the past now. Contemporary collegians are far too wrapped up in matters of moment. They take everything seriously these days, including themselves, and it's almost possible to tender them praise while hiding our pity.

—Gov't Hides Facts To Head Off Panic

Human beings are simply pawns in the games of alien minds that control our every move. Our whole life and the complete existence of this universe is at the whim of these creatures that hold fantastic mental powers over us.

So says Fred Hoyle, the famed British astrophysicist and author.

"They are everywhere," he said in a special press conference held in London, "in the sky, on the sea and on the earth. They have been here since the beginning of time and control nearly everything we do!"

Hoyle told the press conference that a large part of the scientific establishment is convinced that another intelligence exists on this planet.

"It is not an intelligence from another planet. It is actually from another universe. It entered our universe at the very beginning and has been controlling all that has happened since."

Hoyle explained the many reasons why the majority of people had no idea of this.

"Panic is the major reason that no general announcement was ever made," he said. "But there have been some books out on the theory.

"But the books have really only circulated in scientific circles and academic markets. The theory and arguments around it are much too technical for non-scientists."

This second universe, said Hoyle, where these powerful minds originally came from, is much like ours and yet on a totally different plane.

"It is probably three-dimensional like ours and may even have a fourth and fifth dimension which breaks the time and space barriers that restrict us.

"But their laws of chemistry and physics are no doubt completely different from ours because they are a much more advanced type of intelligence.

"They seem to be totally free of any physical restrictions, such as bodies. They are like pure thought and can be anywhere at any time they please."

Hoyle pointed out that this intelligence probably controlled our complete evolution and continues to control our minds. All of what man has built and become, was done because of the tinkering of these intelligent forces.

"And the weirdest thing about it," said Hoyle, "is that at times they actually appear in physical forms.

"In this way they have been responsible for almost all of the legends in different countries which are scoffed at today. They also had a hand in the different things which were discovered in only some parts of the world and not others."

Astrophysicist Hoyle, who is known throughout the world as one of the best, could not give concrete details about the intelligence.

"They are so different from what we know," he said, "that to try and describe them in language that everyone would understand would be impossible."

Hoyle said that teams of philosophers and linguists (language specialists) had described them fairly well, but only in technical terms. Mathematicians also have had success in drawing a verbal picture of the creatures, but only in numbers.

Hoyle then explained that they had the power to appear anywhere as anything.

"They take any shape or form. They can appear as a tiger in one place or a person in another. They can appear as a gas or a cloud or anything that can be seen by the human eye and even in some forms that cannot be seen by the naked eye."

Hoyle said that the most recent documented incident of their appearance was at sea.

"Dozens of ships were following something on the sonar. It was traveling 250 knots and 20,000 feet deep. There is nothing on earth that can go that far and that deep."

The biggest problem about informing the public, said Hoyle, is with the government.

"The only reason I call this press conference is that no government in the world would release this information.

"They fear panic among the people. They think that if the people know that some intelligent force is controlling them they will no longer listen to the governments.

"For these reasons, all information has been suppressed and hidden."

Hoyle said that he did not expect many people to believe everything he said at the press conference.

"Most people . . . well, most . . . many people will think that this is a half-brained theory and just laugh it off. Others will be worried and check with police or governments.

"Naturally the government will deny everything."

"But most scientists were notified weeks ago and agreed that it would be a good thing to at least get the story out and let the public chew on it.

"A little at a time, more facts will be released until everyone has access to all the information which is now only in the hands of scientists and government officials."

Engine Stolen

Thief Abandons Train Before Crash

Lake Geneva, Wis. (AP)

A switching engine was stolen from the Crystal Lake, Ill., switching yards of the Chicago and North Western Railway early today and driven 27 miles to Lake Geneva where it rammed into a standing suburban train, empty except for a sleeping crewman.

Railway spokesmen in Chicago said damage was extensive to the commuter locomotive. The collision blocked the branch track preventing use of two parked trains for today's commuter runs to Chicago.

"Someone had to take that engine out of the yard and get it up to the branch line," a railway spokesman said. "There are several switches

that have to be pulled and a main line has to be crossed."

The official said there was no way of knowing when the person who took the engine jumped off.

"He certainly didn't stay aboard for the collision," the spokesman said.

One railway employe in a passenger car of the parked train received minor injuries.

The spokesman said commuters were taken by bus from Lake Geneva to Crystal Lake but service at the first three or four stops en route to Chicago was disrupted.

It was not determined when the wreckage would be cleared. There was no estimate of the damages.

Monster's Prey a Real Doormaker

Fouke, Ark. (AP) — The hottest thing going in this farming community of 394 is a tour of the old Crank home on U.S. 71 where Bobby Ford, 25, was alleged attacked by a large, hairy animal with fire-red eyes.

Ford lived in the home less than five days when he ran into the "monster." He was so scared he ran right through the front door—without opening it.

Ford describes the animal as about 6 feet tall, black and hairy. Ford said it runs on its hind legs too swiftly to be a bear.

Ford says he's moving. Cars have jammed the yard in front of the house, as children with their dogs and men and women with babies on their hips look at the "monster" tracks.

The constable feels that whatever kind of animal it was, it was making its den under the house until Ford moved in.

Empty Yacht Found Drifting in Atlantic

WILLEMSTAD, Curacao (AP) — Bjorn Christian Lohr's 29-foot yacht Frilo has been brought here after being found drifting undamaged but empty in the Atlantic.

Authorities said they have no clues to the fate of the 51-year-old Danish-born Lohr, who left Dec. 31 on a solo Atlantic crossing, called at Corunna, Spain, several days later, and hasn't been heard from since.

500-pound cannon stolen in Centralia

CENTRALIA, Ill. (AP) — A 500-pound Civil War cannon barrel was stolen off a memorial in Centralia's Elmwood Cemetery, police reported Wednesday.

Authorities said the 4-foot-long cannon was taken either Monday or Tuesday night and apparently the thief needed a winch truck with a lifting frame to haul it away.

Police said they were trying to determine whether there was a connection with vandalism at a vacant house two miles west of Centralia.

Investigators theorize someone had to use a winch truck to tear the porch off the house and topple the chimney. The damage was discovered Tuesday.
