THOSE "FACES" IN SAUCER PHOTOS

In the June issue of SS&S we printed a story about the discovery of faces which appear in some flying saucer photographs. One person personally mentioned to your editor that this could be the secret of telling whether a flying saucer photo was real or fake. In other words, the fake photo wouldn't show any faces. However, the fact remains that the faces seen are not at all friendly but are devilish in appearance and you might wonder if this is so, how could the saucerians be friendly? Well, this is all in our own minds when we connect certain faces with either good or bad entities. For instance, we've all met at one time or another somebody who would give you the shirt off his back but wasn't exactly your idea of being handsome. So let us read on and find out what readers have to say about SOMO this fascinating discovery:

The results of the photographs are very interesting and do bear some relationship to Trevor James endeavors years back, although James' photos, to me at least, never revealed anything as detailed as what you say turned up on the Galt photos. I could never distinguish anything in his photos which could even be loosely construed as more than blotches and blobs. I seem to recall that he identified his photographed "animals" as amoeba-like and inhabiting the atmosphere in great numbers. in certain areas. However, the drawings in SS&S could not be mistaken for anything except "faces", perhaps of beings of some nature. Bill Lamb has for years, advocated that the UFO's are transformations of evil entities and this theory I understand is quite similar to John M. Cage, who believes that the UFO's are not tangible machines but spacelife that "creates" itself, taking any shape form or color scheme it desires. I have never quite come to any conclusion as this and still contend that the UFO is a tangible object "used" by the angelic race, for transportation. Be this as it may, your drawings on

page two indicate something entirely lifferent from anything I have seen. The "faces" in the photos...the April 23rd photo and the Jordan photo...how would you account for the "bodyless" heads, eyes and one complete being, having been picked up with the photos of the saucers and yet completely detached from them? Could they have been near the saucer or saucers and yet not the same as the entities which were perhaps "inside" the saucers proper? I have a reason for asking this.... it's something I have been working on for some time and it has to do with the demons mentioned in the New Testament as being of a different order than the angelic beings. 





Gray Barker --

Like yourself, I am VERY INTERESTED in the "faces in saucer pictures. I I have been looking through saucer mags and books for good examples of "spirit faces" and have come up with a few pretty good ones. Since I am not too good at seeing these myself, it is my feeling that once I start showing these pictures to an audience, the audience will suddenly discover many "faces" that I did not see when I selected them. I understand, from a conversation with Jack Robinson of New Jersey, that Gladys Fusaro of New York State commented about SS&S rather dramatically when she expressed wonderment at why you would DARE to publish the write-up about the faces in the Galt

pictures.

There must be some general idea going around that this stuff is somehow forbidden.

Now you wanted some comment about the faces and what I think of them.

It is my opinion that a great number of "faces" we see in such pictures represents the same sort of thing as looking at clouds or trees or rock cliffs and mentally forming them into faces and various images. A grouping of trees, or clouds, for example, in a picture, would represent the same thing, and I don't believe we can ascribe anything mystical about it, as we couldn't by actually viewing the objects mentioned in real life and forming them into images.

In regard, however, to other images in pictures, such as in dark spots on the print, etc. let us remember that it is a rather wide belief that images of spirits can often manifest on a film emulsion, which may be somehow sensitive to this thing that the eye cannot see. If we can believe in such discarnate entities we can go a bit farther and entertain the thought that they might be able to impinge themselves, into our physical world, by affecting the emulsion of the film which is so unstable it is affected by so light a stimulus as slight exposure to light. I am speaking, of course, of ordinary "spirit pictures" in which images of departed relatives and other spirits are said to have got on the film without any hocus pocus by the photographer in the darkroom. The sort of thing we're into now, however, is a bit different from the above.

The type of pictures we're looking at now have not been taken during trance sessions with mediums present, and the "faces" are not usually clearly definable, and do not usually include any "body". The most of the faces I've seen are rather horrible looking which suggest some sort of evil. You have to look for these pictures, usually, before you see them. It seems to me that if the faces ARE real, that some sort of entity is somehow impressing he photographic process with

an IDEA rather than a direct image (as in usual "spirit photos").

I don't fully understand the photographic process, but understand that usually, a silver salt is affected by light, and changes its physical composition slightly, so that it is acted upon by a developing solution. The stimuli to change this silver salt need not be great, such as application of heat or mechanical manipulation, for example.

Instead the rather subtle exposure to - rays of light causes it to react and/ or change slightly.

I think that if telekinesis would work on anything, it perhaps would be easier to apply to a photographic emulsion. (We have many reports of people mentally affecting photo emulsions).

Now if we had some sort of entity rather close to our own plane of existence, wanting to impress itself upon our physical existence, it might be easier for it to appear on a film than to pop out of a closet and yell "boo." Because the faces I have seen are usually rather unpleasant, I am wondering if they might come from the so-called astral region. which is supposed to be rather close to ours in terms of "four-D" wavelengths. I understand the astral regions to contain entities of a lower order of spiritual development than ours, and not necessarily consisting of discarnate earth people, but an entirely different "class of people".

I think that contacts with the astral region in the past have led to our popular conception of the appearance of evil spirits, the devil, etc. To us these entities likely would appear in this fashion, for we associate "evil" with a lower stage of spiritual development, and with a kind of physical ugliness.

Whatever this is all about, I can certainly see no danger in exploring this field, other than the possibility of getting scared or going to the booby hatch.

SUNGMA UFOLOGIST ANALYZES THE

THRESHER MYSTERY

"Great events cast shadows ahead!" The Thresher disaster was foreshadowed by a mysterious something still unsolved. A sighting of about 18 alleged 'icebergs' 350 miles due east of Cape May, N.J., by Navy Airmen on Dec. 30, 1961, six months after the iceberg season. Competent Navy personnel saw them but were not seen again after that. In my opinion, they were an alien, extraterrestrial fleet of camouflaged amphibian spacecraft appearing when on the surface as floating icebergs. The setting for an enigma enshrouding a U.S.



submarine, testing and diving off the coast of Massachusetts a year and some months later was in the making. Fantastic as it may seem, one of these ocean-floor based aquatic spacecraft rammed the Thresher intentionally with devastating, instant, deadly results. The total short-circuiting of all electronic devices on the atomic-powered sub has defied scientific explanation as well as to explain the swiftness of attack upon the Thresher by an alien. out-of-this-world power. This leaves no doubt, that "THEY" don't tolerate any detection which could spoil a master plan, not hatched within earthling mentalities, but by such as had come via space to a north polar region rendezvous, for a conquest, vaguely familiar with H.G. Wells "War of the Worlds"! With one important difference, to use the ocean floor which

covers three parts of this planet, instead of land-based spacecraft, aquatic, hard-to-detect, thus superior type spacecraft, employed to install for an alien, extraterrestrial government the advance projects of underwater domes upon the ocean floor of the various water masses belonging to this planet.

Remember, that radar picks up metallic objects exclusively and icebergs are NOT metallic. Going down to investigate, we see icebergs, bits and pieces, some of them 300 to 800 feet long. Reporting their findings to the Coastguard at Boston, to Capt. Ross P. Bullard of the International Ice Patrol, so as to conduct a search for the ICE.

A few hours, ten-mile-square search of the area in Bullard's plane brought no results, not a trace of ice, all of which is mystifying indeed, unless one tackles the subject from an entirely different angle, which involves another mystery, the disappearance of A-sub Thresher with a crew of 120 as of April 10, 1963.

AIR FORCE PROBES 'MYSTERY LIGHT'

Wayne City, Ill. An AF intelligence officer was expected to investigate a huge dazzling light in the sky which frightened a Wayne County family. He will question the 15 to 20 persons who reported seeing the light early Monday, then report his findings to the AF and Dr. A. Hynek of North Western U. Dr. Hynek is the Air Force's consultant astronomer on aerial phenomena. "At the present stage, we don't know what this light was," he said. Ronnie Austin, 18, told officials the mystery light pursued his auto at speeds up to 120 miles and hour early Monday while he drove a girl home from a drive-in movie at Mount Vernon. The light was reportedly spotted again Wednesday night by residents of Fairfield, 17miles east of here.

Callers reported the light about 800 feet off the ground. Some said the light went out when a plane flew by and went back on again when the plane had passed.

Mike Hill, 57, operator of a Fairfield cleaning plant, said the object "looked like a kite affair with a long tail and things projecting from it."(Chicago Daily News, Credit: Wm. Gryzik, Chicago)

'LIGHT IN SKY' CHASES CAR, BESIEGES HOME OF FARMER

Fairfield, Ill. Aug.5/63. A Wayne county family cowered in their darkened house early today while a bright light hovered over their farm for several hours until it disappeared shortly before dawn.

Harry Lee, Wayne county deputy sheriff, said the light was apparently high in the sky and was bigger and brighter than any star. He described it as moving but not twinkling and said he kept it under observation for several hours.

Ronnie Austin described the light as big as an automobile and said when it swooped near him it caused his car motor to crackle. He raced his car but couldn't outdistance the light. A strange object travelling slowly in the sky was sighted in the Gatineau early Sunday, according to Henri Perrault, 38 Glen Ave., who wrote to Dr. C.S. Beals, Dominion astronomer about Perrault says he was on his ver-1t. andah of his Grand Lake cottage at 4:35 am when he saw a "very small, oblong, fiery object emitting a short fiery trail at irregular intervals. It seemed about 800 feet up. It was definitely below the clouds, he wrote. "It emitted no noise and travelled in a west-south-west direction on a horizontal course," he said. RCAF Uplands control tower said there were no aircraft in the air at the time of the sighting. (The Ottawa Citizen, June 11, 1963)

A Chicagoan said Tuesday he was chased for almost two hours by a huge white light while returning by auto from a vacation in Canada last September. Howard M. Horwich, 25, of 7525 North Claremont, said he was telling his story now because of news reports that a Wayne County family had been dogged by a similar light last Monday night. Horwich said he and a friend, Louis Edelman, 28, of 855 W. Buena, were driving at night along a deserted road in a forest between Sudbury and Toronto (Ontario) when the light appeared. He said it was circular in shape and as large as the car or larger, and it hovered, spinning overhead. It was particularly strange because it seemed to give off little radiance, Horwich said. He said they tried to communicate with it without success. While looking at it, it shot a beam at a passing train for a few seconds. Horwich tried to evade it by making quick stops and by speeding. 

Bill Rawlinson commented very ably on both the problem and the answer which I had presented earlier in your columns, (SS&S March, 1963) as to how mankind had made a sudden leap forward technologically during the past 150 years after spending thousands in the horse and cart stage.

I listed, too, great men and women, who in this same short period had given spiritual and philosophical concepts to humanity, such as Madame H.P. Blavatsky, Rudolf Steiner, Mary Baker Eddy, Krishnamurti, Ouspensky and Gurdjieff. However, I left out the authority Mr. Rawlinson quoted in his article, namely, Emanuel Swedenborg, because that great man lived in an earlier time (1688-1772). I agree that Swedenborg had the answer, or at any rate, part of it.

Mr. Rawlinson advanced what he called 'a more adequate explanation', and this he described as 'not other-planet but other-worldly in nature. I agree entirely. I never intended to indicate in my article that my explanation was purely 'other-planet'. In fact, I used the phrase 'other spheres', as indicative of the origin of our Visitors. It is true that in writing about the work of very effectual people as being preparatory for the expansion of human consciousness, I suggested this was preliminary to present plans for migration from this planet to outer space. These plans are what mankind hopes to carry out based upon modern scientific thought and research.

What did I mean by 'other spheres'? From a chnical point of view, other spheres may mean other chemical planets. From an esoteric point of view this may not be the case, and there may well be other universes of a different order of magnitude. In other words, as the alchemists used to believe, there may be a Macrocosm in addition to the Microcosm (our own chemical universe which I termed the Cosmic Egg for a very special reason.)

Popular religion, whether it goes by the name of Christianity or any other form of faith, usually teaches that there are two places to go after death and dissolution of the chemical body. It is supposed that one of these places is The Right Place for Everybody and that the other place is The Wrong Place for Everybody. This idea degenerates into the notion that one of the places is The Good Place and the other is The Bad Place. The religion, whatever it is, advocates one and condemns the other, and sets forth whatever rules for admission apply.

The esoteric attitude, on the other hand, appreciates the situation differently, and, we like to think, a bit more broadly. Popular belief, in order to survive, must have its roots in arcane fact, however far its interpretations may stray from the essential knowledge.

The esoteric (or the occult or the arcane or whatever you may choose to call it) statement is that there are other universes in addition to the chemical universe. creation, it is everything.

However, humanity has constructed machines which tell him there are large areas of that universe, areas of energy and form, of which his bodily senses leave him entirely unaware.

'Thing' Hunk of Jelly, Cavorting in Atlantic Ocean

Saniy Hook, N.J. (AP) A "thing" described as a 40-foot-long hunk of jelly is reported cavorting in the Atlantic. It undulated near the surface in a menner resembling the storied sea serpents, says Dr. Lionel A. Walford, director of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife research centre here.

- "But please be careful not to call it a sea serbent," says Walford, who saw • the creature.
- "It is an invertebrate," he added. "It looked like so much jelly. I
- could see no bones and no eyes, nose or mouth. But, there it was, undulating along looking as if it were almost made of fluid glass."
- The "thing" was sighted 25 miles southeast of Times Square off Sandy Hook.

'It was at least 40 feet in length, and about five inches thick and perhaps 7 to 8 inches deep -- looking something like an enormously long flattened eel," Said Walford. The "thing" was sighted from a research vessel as scientists were lowering two frogmen in a shork-proof iron "bird cage" to make oceano graphic studies. Sharks are common in the area.

- Walford, anxious to photograph the "thing", plans to soil back to the scene with floodlights today. During the last two weeks, a large and dangerous form of stinging jellyfish has turned up on New Jersey and Long
- Island, N.Y., beaches. Most were about two feet in diameter.

The workmen are reluctant to have their names linked with the stories about the ghost's appearance. But recently, it's claimed, one of the women in the hangar spoke to the ghost when he suddenly appeared walking across the building. "Hey, mate," the woman shouted, "you must not go through there." But the ghost walked on and vanished through the wall.

"It was a little disturbing at first," said one of the workmen, "but we are getting used to him now."

Not very many people have witnessed a meteorite landing. Even fewer have found a meteorite on their own property. Still fewer are the people who have found a meteorite that turned out to be artificial.

Clayton Matthews of Brigden, Ontario, is the only man in the world who has had all three experiences.

Meteorites, artificial or otherwise, are not new to Mr. Mathews.

In the same general area in 1939 he witnessed the flaming, roaring landing of what was later to be termed the Dresden meteorite, an 88-pound chunk of metal, mostly iron, that fell on a farm near Dresden. Then 19, on his father's farm, Mr. Matthews was standing in the kitchen when the meteorite landed at early dusk. "I saw that one go through the sky," he said. "It left a track of smoke and


it was like a flash of lightning with a big bang of thunder."







FLYING SAUCERS REACH COMMONS

London, July 25 (UPI) Air Minister Julian Amery was asked today to assess the possibility the mysterious crater in farmer Roy Blanchard's farm might have been made by a UFO or flying saucer.

The crater caused Laborite Roy Mason to submit a question to Mr. Amery re saucers.

Army bomb experts who have dug about seven feet down in the crater have said their instruments indicate there is something metallic underneath. In Scotland, police are just as baff-'led by two other craters, these were discovered on James Brown's farm, 21 miles south of Dunbar in E. Lothian. Each of the craters is about 16 feet across and 2 or 3 feet deep. Forty feet away are great lumps of earth with channels up to 44 feet long radiating away. Nearby are a series of square holes about a foot wide and two feet deep. (Washington Daily News. July 24, 1963. Credit: Eleanore McConkey, Wash., D.C.)

Australian astro-physicist Robert Randall is convinced the hole was caused by a 600-ton, 50-man flying saucer from "somewhere in the region of Uranus".

Blanchard's neighbour reported that a nearby cow of his was suffering from an unusual skin disease. It looked as if it had been exposed to immense heat or radiation.

Dr. Randall investigated and formed the theory that a spacecraft made an emergency landing, bounced across 3 fields and then righted itself. The forced landing with its tripod suction feet caused the lO-foot wide crater and a 50-foot circle of flattened barley in another field was evidence of the first "hop". "If this was following a definite pattern," he said, "there were similar

authenticated landings in Australia in 1954 and 1955 and in France in 1957 and 1958.

Randall also said he believed the saucer's solar batteries failed and that it's crew had to repair it.

DOZENS SEE 'FIRE IN SKY' GO POOF!

About a dozen Londoners (Ontario) last night reported seeing an unidentified object burn in the northeast sky "like a ball of fire". Alfred Simpson, one of those who saw the phenomenon from his home at 10 Arg yle St., said a reddish glowing object appeared "all of a sudden". He said it "burned for a minute and a half to two minutes (while moving steadily) and you could see small pieces burning as they dropped off. "Then the whole thing started to fall, quite fast. All of a sudden 'poof'. the fire went out" City Airport reported all aircraft in the area accounted for. City. provincial police and firemen said they had no reports of any object crashing. ARE WE ENTERING - OR LEAVING?

By Wilbert B. Smith

With atomic energy we are crossing a threshold, but are we entering or leaving?

Much has been said and written about the awful devastation which would be caused by an atomic war. It has been suggested, and with just cause, that such a war probably would wipe out civilization, leaving the remnants of the human race in atavistic savagery, if there were any remnants. Dr. Hugh Keenlyside, former Under Secretary of State for External affairs for Canada estimates that there are in existence at the present time more than 150,000 nuclear devices, many more than required to do the job.

Consider what happens when an atom bomb explodes. The fission process which comprises the explosion releases enormous quantities of energy which originates within even the hottest star. If only ten percent of the energy available in Uranium 235 or Plutonium were suddenly converted into heat, the temperature of the mass would jump to the order of fifty billion degrees centigrade. Even if the blast were diluted by five hundred times as much inert material as there was active material, the temperature would still be of the order of one hundred million degrees.

Now, the temperature of the sun, as we determine it, is about six thousand degrees on the surface and about ten or twenty million degrees in the interior. It is presumed to derive its energy from the conversion of hydrogen to helium through an intermediate cycle involving carbon, oxygen and nitrogen, which cycle progresses very smoothly at the sun's temperature. If , however, the sun's temperature were much higher the hydrogen could convert directly, first into deuterium, tritium, and helium, without benefit of the time delay and stabilizing action of the carbon-nitrogen-oxygen cycle, and would produce most probably an explosion of increasing magnitude which would continue until it either ran out of hydrogen or the eventual expansion of the gasses produced a sufficient drop in temperature to stop the reaction.

Suppose that an atom bomb (either fission or fusion type) landed in a large body of fresh water such as one of our Great Lakes, and furthermore, that it sank to a considerable depth before exploding. The explosion, when it did take place would be confined by walls of water consisting largely of hydrogen, since two thirds of the atoms in water are hydrogen. Before the bubble of hot gasses resulting from the explosion could overcome the inertia of the water and rise to the surface, it is almost certain that the. water directly in contact with the blast would be heated to temperatures comparable with that of the blast it- " self, one hundred million degrees or hotter. At such temperature the hydrogen in the water would be in prime condition to convert directly into helium and would in fact become a "hydrogen bomb" with the release of about the same or greater energy per unit mass as was released from the active material of the bomb itself. Consequently, a thermo-nuclear chain reaction would probably set in which would be cumulative and self-propagating. Once initiated it would continue increasing in intensity until stopped by either a lack of hydrogen or the eventual drop in temperature of the expanding gasses. In any case the reaction would probably persist until most of the available hydrogen had gone up in helium.

Should such a thing happen, even by accident, and an atom bomb explode deep in one of our fresh waterlakes, with thousands of tons of hydrogen available, there could result a blast of such intensity that it would envelope the entire planet in a few seconds, vaporizing everything on it surface &. maybe even shattering the core, and producing a celestial display visible throughout the galaxy. Unfortunately, we would be in no position to observe it as we would have ceased to exist.

The foregoing is not idle speculation. It is based on the same data, calculations and measurements which produced the atom bomb, and the fact of the bomb is grim testimony to its potentialities. We may well ask ourselves the question -- we are crossing the threshold, but are we entering or just leaving? (Ottawa F.S. Club)

UNDERSEA WALL IS A DEEP PUZZLE

Washington, Aug.14--Discovery of an unbroken wall about 30 feet high and several hundred feet wide, which extends for approximately 100 miles under the Atlantic on both sides of the mouth of the Orinoco, has just been announced by Dr. D.F. Squires, associate curator of marine invertebrates at the Smithsonian Institution.

The Orinoco wall constitutes at present one of the most inexplicable undersea phenomena.

'The discovery was announced in the journal of the Woods Hole, Mass., Oceanographic Institute.

The wall, says Squires, is composed of masses of shell material, pebbles and sand cemented together by some means not yet known, all of which is grown over by a living mat of algae. There is no evidence that this was built by coral skeletons. The structure extends to depths of 45 to 65 fathoms. (The Detroit News, credit: Richard Katuzin, Dearborn Hts. Mich.)

THE MOVING LIGHT THAT DOESN'T

This is the story of a stationary light....that moves. A contradiction in terms? Well, for years people have been sitting in a research laboratory at the University of Alberta watching this unmoving light. And as they watch, they see it move.

This spectacle of people studiously tracing the movement of a light that doesn't move is a psychological phenomenon known as "autokinetic movement" which psychologists have been studying since the dawn of modern psychology.

"I got interested in this funny little phenomenon," explains Dr. Joseph Royce head of the department of psychology at U of A, "because when I read about it I just didn't believe it." Dr. Royce believes it now. In fact, the stationary light obliges with considerable movement for him. This is what happens. A person is placed in a room, totally dark except for a stationary pinpoint of light. Watching the light, the person's normal reaction is that it moves. Amount of movement varies. A very small percentage see no movement. Most see a moderate amount. The path of movement is essentially unpredictable and usually erratic. "Our theory is it moves because it has no frame of reference--nothing to anchor it to," Dr. Royce says. Frame it in a circle of light and the pinpoint stops moving. There are common instances of perceived illusion of movement similar to the phenomenon of light. Ever sit in a train, stopped at a station, when a train on an adjacent track started to "I'm interested in the basic move? phenomenon itself," says Dr. Royce. I want to know why it moves. He has been doing research on autokin-

etic movement since 1955 and has been aided with grants from several agencies, including the U.S.A.F. The U.S.A.F. is interested because there is some evidence that autokinetic movement had caused plane acci-

UFOS OVER WOBURN, MASS.

On June 7, 1963, an eight pound mysterious metal object crashed with an explosion-like force on the porch steps of Mr. & Mrs. James C. McDonald of 16 Ballou St., West Quincy. On June 22, Mr. Richard Pothier, Quincy Ledger Staff photographer, caught a mysterious UFC on film from his backyard at his Wollaston home, and on July 21, mysterious pebble-like objects. fell and exploded outside a bowladrome in Quincy and were witnessed by dozens of eyewitnesses.

Other New Englanders watched a spectacular sun eclipse on July 20, but perhaps the greatest thrill came to a large number of Woburn children, who watched a "V" formation of five yellowish-white oval-shaped saucers in flight on July 22 at around 3 p.m. The youngsters viewed the phenomena from Grace Road, West Woburn.

The strange unknown flying objects, flying at speeds faster than jets, as they passed overhead, made a strange whirring or whistling sound and maneuvered in the skies only a matter of seconds, but left a group of excited and puzzled youngsters. Mike Hennessey, 13, of 7 Menchin Drive and James Trider, 14, of 28 Rich Road said the UFOs looked like the often described 'flying saucers' reported worldwide many times before.

George D. Fawcett, Woburn UFO investigator, checked through his records and found that the UFOs were photographed in England, Hawaii, Australia, Japan, Argentina, Massachuseets, Washington State, Kansas, California, Poland, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Israel, New Hampshire, Venezuela, Canada and Italy in 1962-1963. Landings during the same period of time were reported in Ohio, . Florida, Argentina, New Jersey, Italy, Colorado, Montana, Nebraska, Washington state and England & Massachusetts. Such sightings are once again on the increase in the New England Area States and worldwide and many of the explosions and fragments reported should be checked for a possible relationship, Fawcett concluded. This is one of the eims of the Mass.-Rhode Island Two-State UFO Study Group for Adults.

WHATS'S NEW IN UFO'S?

"SKY-O-WISPS!" By Wm. C. Lamb.

This road had no bumps or bad spots, when suddenly and BaNG ... the front end of my car (a model A Ford Coupe) was lifted at least two feet off the road straight up and sideways, and missing a culvert abutment made out of cemeric. by about 6 feet.
